

Eucharistic Adoration Chapel (Parish Center):


8:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

From the Pastor's Desk,

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Every summer, after school's out, I think to myself that this is the time when things will be a little less busy in church life. Indeed things are a little less busy, but there are still many events and activities to grow in our faith. While we've returned to ordinary time for a couple of weeks, we've still had the two major feasts of Holy Trinity and Corpus Christi to celebrate on the weekends. This weekend we finally return to seeing the green colors in church and in the priest and deacon garments. A final return to green is a good reminder that, even as schooling and education have ended for now, we are still called to grow in our faith.

Summer is a good time to grow, and not just for the plants and trees outside.
