August Health Ministry News This month we would like to focus on *Food Safety for Warmer Weather*. Picnics and backyard gatherings happen often in the summer, but with the warmer temperatures you have a greater chance of getting food poisoning. Symptoms of food poisoning: vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, fever or chills that can occur within a few hours or a few days depending on the type of bacteria which caused the illness. Prolonged or severe symptoms, contact your healthcare provider. To help prevent food poisoning do this simple steps:

Wash hands for at least 20 seconds with soapy water before and after handling food or using the bathroom.

Wash fruits and vegetables before eating.

**Avoid** undercooked seafood, meats and eggs. Cook foods to their proper temperature

**Keep** raw meat, poultry, seafood and their juices away from other foods.

**Keep** hot foods hot and cold foods cold. Promptly refrig erates foods that can spoil, within 1 hr.

Use only pasteurized dairy foods and eggs.
