Being Channels of God's Peace

Today the Church **reminds** us that Jesus truly is the **Lord of history**, that God's Providence is **powerful enough** to guide the course of world events, and to bring **meaning and order** to the struggles and sufferings of our own lives.

This loving and wise omnipotence of God, revealed by the **babe in Bethlehem**, is meant to be the source of our **interior peace**, a peace that goes **deeper** than the stormy circumstances all around us.

If we **put our faith** in this message, like Mary in today's Gospel, we too will be called **blessed**.

But there is **another part** to God's Providence.

Mary didn't just **believe** in God's promise; she **acted** on her belief.

She said **yes** to God's invitation; she **put her life** in his hands.

In fact, her yes was the **full expression** of her faith.

During this week before Christmas, **we too** have a chance to give our faith in God its **full expression**.

God's Providence guides the course of history, but he doesn't want his children to just be spectators - he invites us to be active partners in his work of everlasting peace.

As we continue through this week, let's make our heavenly Father smile by accepting that invitation.
