The residents of Nazareth resisted that draw, that change, and as a result, Jesus "was not able to perform any mighty deed there."

When Jesus renews his commitment to us at each Mass, let's promise to hear and also to heed him, every day, so that his mighty deeds will have free rein to work wonders in our lives.
