

The program we are currently viewing is a 6-week series titled Lectio *Prayer: Finding Intimacy with God* by Dr. Tim Gray. There's an introduction, then viewing of a 30 minute video and then a discussion. The session usually lasts 60-90 minutes.

The topics include 1) An Intimate Dialogue, 2) A Way of Ascent, 3) Climbing the First Rungs, 4) Conversation with God, 5) The Gaze of Love, and 6) Putting Love into Action. In six video sessions, *Prayer: Finding Intimacy with God* captures the secret to opening our hearts and minds to Scripture as the means to hear from God and then respond in conversation, basking in his presence and resolving to live in and through his love.

Saint of the Week

Anthony of Egypt Feast Day—January 17 c. 251-356



Associated with the beginnings of monasticism, Anthony gave his inherited lands and wealth in Egypt to the poor. From the age of about 20 until his death at 105 years old, he lived as a hermit in remote hilltop and desert locations. What is known about him comes from a hagiography written by St. Athanasius of Alexandria. Around the year 306, Anthony began to accept disciples, founding his first monastery as a collection of hermits' cells. He cultivated a garden, wove rush mats, and fought many temptations and demons. Visitors sought his wise counsel, collected in the sayings of the "desert fathers," and the bishops of Alexandria summoned him at age 87 to help refute Arianism. He is the patron of basket and brush makers, butchers, gravediggers, and skin diseases.

Speaking about the power of the monastic life during his visit to Egypt, Pope Francis exhorted, "I urge you . . . draw upon the example of St. Paul the Hermit, St. Anthony, the holy Desert Fathers, and the countless monks and nuns who by their lives and example opened the gates of heaven to so many of our brothers and sisters. You too can be salt and light, and thus an occasion of salvation for yourselves and for all others, believers and non-believers alike, and especially for those who are poor, those in need, the abandoned and discarded" (Address, April 29, 2017)



Safe Environment Program Compliance

Archdiocesan policy mandates that all persons who work with children be in full compliance with the Safe Environment Program. Compliance involves: 1) attending a Protecting God's Children workshop; 2) reading and signing a Code of Ethical Conduct; and 3) completion of a Family Care Safety Registration form which allows the parish to run a State of Missouri background check. These are to be completed before a person can begin their ministry.

Background checks for all active volunteers are updated in even years. Our parish is in the process of updating all necessary background checks for 2018. If you are no longer active in your ministry, please call the parish Child Safety Coordinator at 636-239-3520. If you are interested in getting involved in a ministry, please let us know, too!
