Kellenberg Memorial High School Reunion



Bibles Banned:

Florida Amid pressure from atheist groups, Orange County Public

Schools banned voluntary Bible distribution in high schools on

January 16, National Religious Freedom Day. The previous three

years, Bibles were placed on a table in a common area for students to

pick up if they chose. But when satanists and antireligion groups announced plans to pass out their own pamphlets, such as "An X-Rated Book sex & obscenity in the Bible" and others, the district decided to ban Bibles along with the objectionable materials.

"State of Libraries Report" for 2016 The Holy Bible finished 6th on the 10 most "challenged" books for schools and libraries. The other 9 books on the list contained demeaning sexual content.

"That anyone would consider banning the Bible - a book that helped shape Western thought from public libraries, whether in your school or neighborhood, is dangerously close to the very censorship the First Amendment is designed to prevent," said First Liberty Institute senior counsel. Jeremy Dvs.
