My Dear Family of St. Therese,

We celebrate this weekend the **Feast** of "The Body and Blood of Christ". For many of us we know it as "Corpus Christi". Formerly it was celebrated on a Thursday – the day of the institution of the Holy Eucharist (Holy Thursday). Since Vatican II, the day has been moved to a Sunday so more people would be able to partake of the celebration.

We are so fortunate that we have the freedom to celebrate Mass often here in the United States. But sadly what happens with such freedom, things, like the celebration of Mass, can be taken for granted. There was a time when if we were caught celebrating the Eucharist, we would be arrested, imprisoned and possibly put to death.

As we celebrate today's feast the question arises as to whether we would risk such a fate if our freedom were lost? Do we attend Mass only when it is convenient or does it have a priority in our life? Is the Mass something that is at the top of our weekly list or is it put in a spot after other activities that we hold more important? Do we truly realize who is present on the altar and in the bread and cup? Are we aware that our "AMEN!" is an acclamation of faith that says "YES! I DO BELIEVE THIS IS THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST!"? A failure to say "Amen" is a statement of disbelief or questioning of the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

As we celebrate our Mass this weekend, let us try to be a little more mindful of **WHO** it is that we receive and welcome **HIM** into our hearts and our life. Let us say our "**AMEN**" loudly, proudly and with confidence.




