



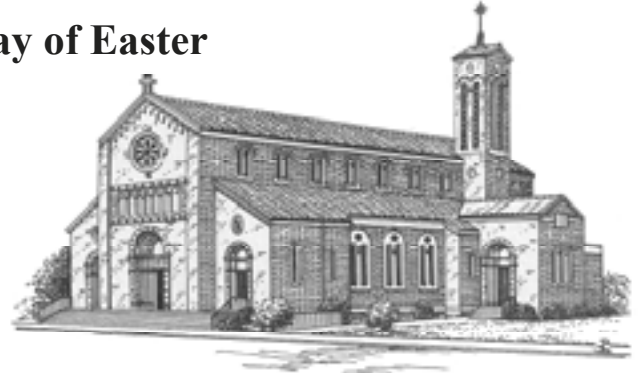

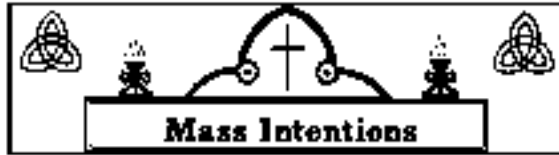

Reflection on the Gospel

The High Priestly Prayer of Jesus

“Holy Father, keep them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one just as we are one.”

If we look back at the time of Protestant Reformation, a vast historical movement caused the division of the whole Christendom. Luther denied the authority of the Pope and simply relied on the Bible as the only yardstick of Christian doctrine. He also denied ordination to the priesthood and elevation to the episcopacy. Instead, he emphasized the idea of the “priesthood of all believers.”

Luther was convinced that the Catholic Church had drifted very far from the teachings of the Sacred Scriptures. One particular loophole he saw was the selling of indulgences to ordinary people which the Church performed. Church officials who were sent out by Pope Leo X to different countries, including Germany, were like salesmen peddling indulgences. It was the time when Pope Leo X’s had needed so badly to raise money for the enlargement and embellishment of St Peter’s Basilica in Rome.

Today’s gospel is evidently a lesson of prayer. What about that? It is a moving prayer of Jesus from the Last Supper episode asking his Father for all of us that we may be one, not divided, as we hear and believe in the word of God, through the church. It is the moment in Jesus’ life that he brings his apostles nearest to the presence of God. He prays for those he loves as he says: “keep them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one just as we are one.”

There is an old adage that goes, ‘let the rule of prayer determine the rule of faith. The church believes as she prays is considered a very important principle in Catholic theology. Hence, as forces of secularism and challenges of modernity continue to emerge as today’s culture of success, power and control, our calling as committed Christians needs to be consistently on a journey, a journey both inward and outward heading for unity and harmony. It is allowing a space for the sacred forces that set our hearts upon Christ. Interspersed with that quest to know oneself in God is a pathway of contemplation, reflection, and love relationship.

I think this is one fundamental element of what it means to be “church,” a community of disciples from different cultures as we try to avoid divisiveness and instead endeavor to spend time in prayer and dialogue. Prayer sustains and strengthens us as we express in loving actions our faith in God. We find a way to bring as much support as possible for those whose lives have been devastated by the loss of their loved ones. For those who are victims of injustice and horror like those survivors of terrorism, war, and violence. For those who come from different faiths and cultures, our concern is basically linked to unity in diversity. We think, for instance, the Lutherans, Anglicans, Presbyterians, Muslims, Buddhists or Hindus, they deserve respect and a welcoming culture for their theological opinions and faith expressions.

Christ, in his final and highest prayer for us, knows very well what lies ahead once he leaves his apostles and goes back to his Father. The road to discipleship involves many tests and trials. And they have to be prepared for all these things. At the core, there is commitment of faith and obedience.
