



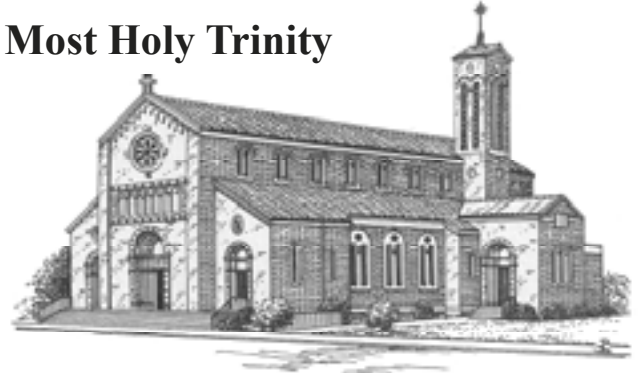

Reflection on the Gospel

The Blessed Trinity

“All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.”

In today’s liturgy of the solemnity of the Blessed Trinity we can glimpse something of God’s mystery in regard to his nature, origin, and mission. At the very heart of God there is the outpouring of love that is so strong and powerful that is shared with us in many ways. It is reflected in the context of relationship. God’s nature and mission is about love as revealed in the historical Jesus. It is a kind of relationship that reaches out to all of us to love because God is love. We can see God’s creative energy in the context of love. It is through a loving relationship with one another that the Blessed Trinity becomes a reflection in our lives. Jesus becomes human to share with us his love; he speaks the words of God to make us part of his kingdom. This is what our Christian faith is all about as we build the community of love, known as the Church.

In Scriptures and in the whole Tradition of the Church, we see that God is revealed as the Blessed Trinity. Though the word “Trinity” is not mentioned in the Bible but the nature of God as it is shown in the book of Genesis implies that God is a family (Gen 5:2-3); God is one (Deut 6:4, Ex 20:3). In the Old Testament we find the glimpse of the Trinity though there is no precise description about the nature of God. There are other names of God which are considered plural form of the divine nature. For instance, El Elyon (Most High God) in Gen. 14:20; El ‘Olam (Everlasting God) in Gene. 21:33; el Shaddai (Almighty God) in Gen. 17:1 and Elohim is the most ancient name.

In the New Testament particularly in the fourth gospel of John, the divinity of Christ is evidently specified (Jn 1:1, 1:18), and Jesus introduced his disciples to ‘*paracletos*’ as Comforter, Advocate and Counselor. Jesus himself is called Lord in the Septuagint and it is often used as an equivalent of Yahweh or God in the New Testament.

As we come to reflect upon the implication of the Blessed Trinity in our lives today we cannot help but be focused on the context of relationships seen in a variety of settings where we find God speaking to us. The tension between the rich and the poor, the powerful and the marginalized, the sick and the dying are challenges that put us together to work for a Trinitarian goal or perspective which is a continuing quest for the values of the Kingdom of God. It is important to keep in mind that the Blessed Trinity communicates with us in love and fellowship
