

#### PASTOR'S CORNER

My Dear Flock.

So let me explain to you what my Tuesdays typically look like. I get up in the morning, maybe go for a brisk walk, then celebrate Mass, then pray for a while, and then walk into my office to have a leisurely day of work. I respond to emails, have a meeting or two, jealously watch through the window as the school kids play at recess, maybe eat some leftover Chipotle for lunch, have another meeting or two, respond to a few phone messages, take a look at my calendar to make sure there are no extra meetings that night, and then, as I'm blissfully packing up to have a relaxing evening in the rectory, Sarah, one of the awesome office staff members, gently reminds me that I have to write a Pastor's Corner by Wednesday morning. Suddenly, the bliss is gone and panic sets in. What am I going to write about? What does the flock need to hear about? What will keep them from trashing the bulletin before even reading two lines from my corner? (I'm just kidding, you would never throw the bulletin in the trash. You'd recycle it, because you're good stewards of the planet.) It is nearly a weekly occurrence and I'm literally writing this at 8:57pm on Tuesday.

Now it's true, that for the last month or so, we have had much going on about which I could write. We had the 150<sup>th</sup>, the Ministry Fair, the installation Mass, and the Young Adult Town Hall. This weekend I could talk about how we are hosting Project Andrew, which is a priesthood discernment event for guys who are high school age and older. It is from 2pm to 5pm this Sunday, October 14<sup>th</sup>, and includes talks from priests, adoration with our Lord, and dinner with the Archbishop. If you are a single guy, in high school or above, come join us in the church at 2pm! If you know a guy that would be good for this event, invite him!

Now we will not have big events every weekend. I can't write about events all the time. So, it probably would be helpful to use the Pastor's Corner to, I don't know, teach. After all, if you read the Corner about my duties as an installed pastor, teaching the flock was stated specifically in Canon Law as a responsibility of a pastor. Having spent five years of schooling in seminary, one would hope that I learned something worth discussing. I took classes in Philosophy, Scripture, Sacraments, Systematic Theology, Liturgy, Church History, Moral Theology, Pastoral Theology, and Canon Law. I could pull out old notes and take quotes from one of the many books on my office shelves (which, by the way, had way too few pictures). But, what is to say that I would find a subject you would enjoy? I could write for weeks on a book called, "Canons and Decrees of the Council of Trent", but I have sneaky suspicion that this would not cause you to show up early each Saturday in anxious anticipation of the new bulletin.

So, being a pastor of the flock, by the flock, and for the flock, I want to know what the flock wants to know. So, I want to solicit possible topics from you, the people of God in Shawnee, KS. Then, my seminarian ghost writer, Keith...I mean, I, Fr. Scott, could sit down and write a corner that I know at least one person would want to read.
