### Sixth Sunday of Easter – B

The commandment to love one another was part of Jesus' final discourse to his disciples on the night before he died. It was his last wish that we love one another as he loves each one of us.

The Second Reading gives the fundamental reason why we have to love one another: "Love comes from God, and everyone who loves is begotten by God and knows God" (1 John 4:7). Loving is an act of God. We who are God's children and are created in His image and likeness, must do what He normally does. By loving one another, we are showing the world that we are not only have God in our lives, but that we really know Him. "Anyone who fails to love can never have known God, because God is love" (1 Jn. 8).

"Love one another as I have loved you" (Jn. 15:12). Jesus made sure that our way of loving would be correct. God's love is unconditional, while ours usually is not. God's love for us was revealed when God sent into the world His only son so that we could have life through him" (1 Jn. 4:9). The love of God is life-giving, not self-serving. It is not driven by sentimental feelings but by a deep and genuine affection for another. Jesus said that "a man can have greater love than to lay down his life for his friends" (Jn.15:13). And this is exactly what he did for us who he calls his friends.
