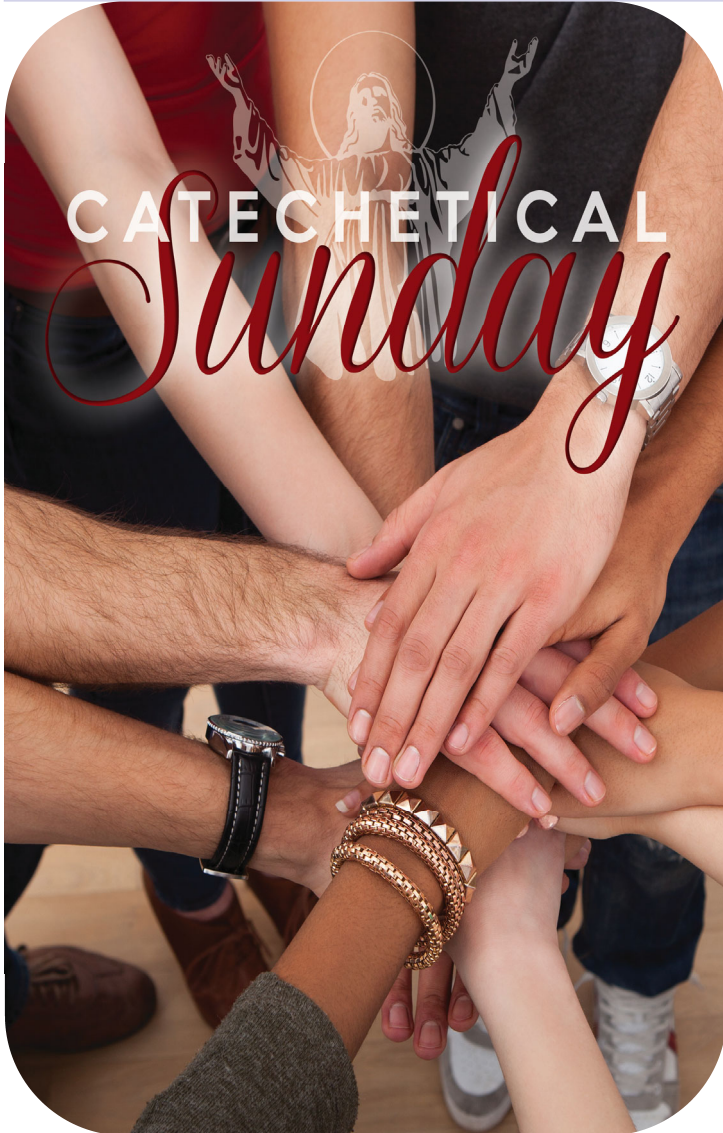

This quote from St. Francis has been my favorite. I have tried to live my life as a man of few words, so I have let the way I live my life show to those around me my love for God. So how do we show our love for God. We start by loving those around us. By taking action to help those in need. In my 37 years here at Assumption. I have never seen in my 33 years as a Deacon the generosity from the people to help when the call to help goes out. This parish will always be in my heart and prayers.

The decision to follow Christ is a defining moment in our lives. It not only gives meaning and purpose to our lives, but can put us on a path that sometimes conflicts with the society in which we live.
