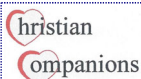
## Pastor Notes

“Where Jealousy and selfish ambitions exist, there is disorder and every foul practice. But the wisdom from above is first of all pure, then peaceable, gentle, compliant, full of mercy and good fruits, without inconstancy or insincerity.” James 3: 16-18

The word of God is living and true; powerful and sharper than a two-edged sword. It is our source of encouragement, strength, and inspiration, but also of reproof and correction. In today's readings from St. James and the Gospel of Mark we see described a life that has lost its focus; one distracted and distorted by what we believe others think, rather than on what we know Jesus commands. Living a life based on Gospel values leaves little room for personal gain, jealousy, and self-importance. It has proven to be a hard lesson to learn. Or maybe few of us really want to learn it. When you look out at the world, most seem to want to be first, the greatest, the one with the most and best “toys”, a wielder of power and influence and authority. Choosing to serve the least doesn't make the top ten on most people's “to do” list.” Lord, help us to follow your call by serving the “least of this life,” especially those more likely to be subject to the cruelty and indifference of our world. Sustain us in this work with the assurance that when we receive them, we receive not only you but the One who sent you. Amen.

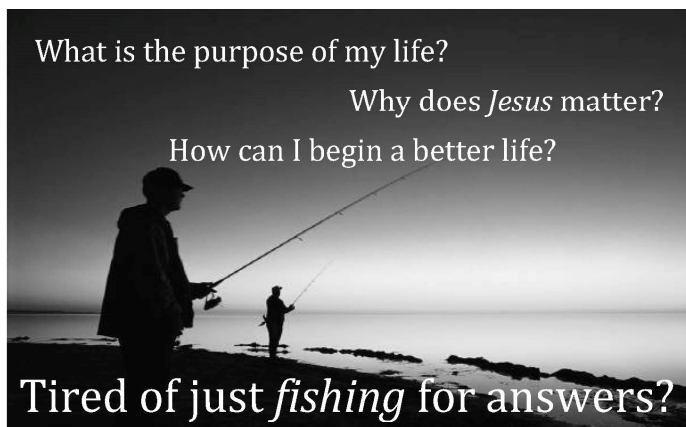


