

St. Maximilian Mary Kolbe—
(1894-1941) a Polish priest who
was known for promoting the
knowledge, love and service of
the Immaculate Virgin Mary.
Along with fellow friars, St.
Maximilian helped care for many
Jewish refugees in Poland after
the invasion by Germany in 1939.

In February 1941, he was arrested and taken eventually to Auschwitz, where in August 1941, he offered his life in exchange for another prisoner condemned to death. He was canonized in 1982 by Pope John Paul II as a martyr of charity.



Reflections on the Sunday Scripture



August 12, 2018

Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings:

1 Kings 19:4-8 Ephesians 4:30-5:2 John 6:41-51

Gospel

The Jews murmured about Jesus because he said. "I am the bread that came down from heaven," and they said, "Is this not Jesus, the son of Joseph? Do we not know his father and mother? Then how can he say, 'I have come down from heaven'?" Jesus answered and said to them, "Stop murmuring among vourselves. No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draw him, and I will raise him on the last day. It is written in the prophets: *They* shall all be taught by God. Everyone who listens to my Father and learns from him comes to me. Not that anyone has seen the Father except the one who is from God; he has seen the Father. Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever believes has eternal life. I am the bread of life. Your ancestors ate the manna in the desert, but they died; this is the bread that comes down from heaven so that one may eat it and not die. I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

- 1. When have you been nourished by the "bread" of kindness, of forgiveness, of wisdom that another offered you?
- 2. The critical verb in today's gospel is "believe." What does this mean to you?
- 3. Have you ever spoken to an unbelieving (murmuring) group about your faith (teachings) of Christ? How did you handle it? Who did you rely on? What did you rely on?

- 4. What does Jesus as bread teach you about the "bread of life"? (Think about spiritual nourishment love, compassion, joy, etc.) As "flesh for the life of the world"? (Think about His teachings that would help you help the world —others).
- 5. During the Mass, were you fed and nourished by the readings and by the "Body of Christ"? If so, how? What did you feel and what did you walk away with?

This Wednesday, August 15th, is the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary and a Holy Day of Obligation.

From: EWTN on the Assumption — The Assumption completes God's work in her since it was not fitting that the flesh that had given life to God himself should ever undergo corruption. The Assumption is God's crowning of His work, as Mary ends her earthly life and enters eternity. The feast turns our eyes in that direction, where we will follow when our earthly life is over.

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they do not look only to the past. They look to the present and to the future and give us an insight to our own relationship with God. The Assumption looks to eternity and gives us hope that we, too, will follow Our Lady when our life is ended.

The prayer for the feast reads: "All-powerful and everliving God: You raised the sinless Virgin Mary, mother of your Son, body and soul, to the glory of heaven. May we see heaven as our final goal and come to share her glory."

In 1950, in the Apostolic Constitution "Munificentissimus Deus," Pope Pius XII proclaimed the Assumption of Mary a dogma of the Catholic Church in these words: "The Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heaven."

With that, an ancient belief became Catholic doctrine and the Assumption was declared a truth revealed by God.

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Mark's,

This past week I received a decree from our Father Provincial, Father Tadeusz Lizinczyk, informing me that I am being transferred to our monastery in Kittanning, PA, near Pittsburgh. Father Provincial is following the rule within our Constitution that we are only allowed to serve a six-year term in parishes outside the monastic setting. This is a regulation that has been set by our General Council in Poland.

It is with a heavy heart that I accept this decree. It is very difficult for me to leave St. Mark's, for it truly is a place where "Friends become Family." That was a motto I gave to this Parish when I was first here back in 2005, and I know that it is true.

These six and a half years have gone by very swiftly, with much having been accomplished. I hope I have touched your hearts with good spirituality, meaningful homilies (I know some have disagreed with my political comments, sorry about that.), my physical labors, decorating efforts, teaching, and all of my God-given talents.

As I review my life here, and what I wanted to accomplish, I hope and pray that the Lord is well pleased by my efforts as His servant as I have always attempted to serve the Lord by serving His people. Upon arriving here, my first and foremost priority was to pay off the large debt, which we did a year and half after I became Pastor here. Parishioners expressed a desire to have stained-glass windows in the lower church, and this dream was realized. Then, with the influx of more parishioners wanting to attend classes in theology, scripture, church history and spirituality, the Enrichment Center was another dream come true because of you and your financial generosity. Additionally, a home for your priests was built on the church property to allow the priests to have closer access to the parish events and to be more available to the parishioners. I have done my best to be open to the needs and desires of the parishioners.

I have tried to lead with kindness and love, teaching with knowledge and an understanding of scripture and church teachings. I have prayed with you and for you, sharing my love for the Eucharist, which is Christ, the Center of our Faith.

Most importantly, I hope that I have been there for you, ready to serve your needs as your Priest and Pastor, through the Sacraments for your growth and spirituality. The loving, sharing and joyful spirit within all your hearts is contagious, and I am grateful to you for sharing that spirit with me. Your kindness and gentleness were always present as I got to know you, and I realize it comes from the heart.

And now, if I have offended any of you with my glib comments or sarcastic remarks, if I was not sensitive to your needs, or if I have failed you in any way, please forgive me. I ask that you remember me in your prayers as you recall all the good that we have done together during my stay here. And, lastly, may you give your new Pastor a warm welcome, and accept him with an open heart without expectations. Please do not expect him to be me.

I thank God for my time with you here.
