CAMPUS DYNAMICS

St. John XXIII Catholic School (SJ23) has two campuses. Our Lower Campus serves students in preschool through 4th grade and our Upper Campus serves students in 5th through 8th grades. In addition to the regular classrooms, both campuses have a computer lab, STEAM Lab, music room, art room, library, Spanish room, cafeteria, and gym. Upper campus also includes a band room.

CURRICULUM

Our curriculum includes Reading, Math (including Pre-Algebra & Algebra), Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, Religion, Technology, Physical Education, Art, and Music. Spanish is offered to students in K-8th grades. Beginning Band, Concert Band, Jazz Band, & Guitar are available to student in grades 5 - 8. STEAM concepts (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, & Math) are integrated throughout our K - 8 curriculum.

In addition to the regular curriculum, middle-school students have additional electives in the areas of fine arts, STEAM/Makerspace, or extended learning/enrichment help. Fine arts electives include mallet madness/world drumming, music technology/video creation, and theater/drama.

INSTRUCTOR/STUDENT RATIO

The average class size at SJ23 is 16 students. The instructional faculty to student ratio is 2:15.

TECHNOLOGY

At SJ23 we believe that technology enhances traditional and hands-on teaching methods to further our students' educational journey both in and outside the classroom. Students use ipads, MacBooks, laptops and chromebooks in the STEAM labs and classrooms to accomplish curricula goals and become respectful, knowledgeable digital citizens.

STEAM LABS

Our STEAM lab is a student-centered environment dedicated to a deeper understanding of real-world concepts and their relationship to each other. The STEAM concept explores Science and Technology, through Engineering and the Arts, all based in Mathematical elements. This hands-on, inquiry approach encourages our K - 8th grade students to investigate and solve real-world problems by incorporating language, fine arts, and music in addition to traditional STEM curriculum.

STUDENT SUPPORT

At SJ23 we support students' individual learning needs and help them reach their highest potential by providing one-on-one and small-group student enrichment. In grades five to eight we have regularly scheduled FLEX time for intervention, project time, reteaching, acceleration, and enrichment. We nurture our students' emotional and social growth weekly through individual or group counseling opportunities that focus on relationships, adolescent challenges, healthy minds and bodies, as well as other topics that promote positive social and emotional growth.

SERVICE, DISCIPLESHIP, & COMMUNITY

All students in K - 8th grade participate in weekly Mass or prayer services and numerous service projects throughout the year. At the Upper Campus, students also participate in retreats, work in the St. Peter's Food Pantry, serve at St. Ben's, and serve in many other areas of our local and global communities. Middle-school students are required to fulfill a fixed number of service hours each year.
