Three Events to Increase Our Time in Prayer

The Stewardship Commission will be scheduling three events over the next several weeks on dates two of which are yet to be determined. We are inviting all of our parishioners to watch for these dates in the bulletin and on our website to join us.

The first event is a day trip to the Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help in Champion Wisconsin, the site of the only approved apparition of our Blessed Mother in the United States, for a day of special prayer intentions. It is a 1½ hour bus ride each way, sponsored by the Knights of Columbus, with lunch included. It will be scheduled on an upcoming Saturday, and if enough interest in attending the 8:30 am Mass, would have to leave no later than 7:00 am. The details are being gathered now for this exciting pilgrimage. Please watch for the flyer, as we will need to make a reservation at the site 14 days in advance.

The second event is a full day of Adoration at St. Mary's Church, to begin after the Wednesday May 23, after the 8:45 am Mass, and conclude the following Thursday, May 24, at 9:30 am. Volunteers will be needed to be in church for 1 hour each, 2-3 people are preferred for each hour, throughout the event. We will be setting up a schedule soon, so please consider being present for an hour of time with the Lord. If we do not have full coverage for the event, Adoration will conclude at 5:30 pm on Wednesday, May 23 as normally scheduled.

The third event is hosting a day of prayer at the Our Lady of Fatima grotto shrine, located at Immaculate Conception in Saukville. The sale of the property has required the relocation of the Shrine across the street to the Church grounds. Once everything is in place and date scheduled, the event will begin at 6:00 am with the Angelis, include Liturgy of the Hours, Rosaries and the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, to conclude shortly after 6:00 pm.
