

From Father Jim...

We are getting so much better at accepting responsibility for caring for our buildings but as a gentle, friendly reminder I present the following:



Staying Cool: The fans in the church and in the sanctuary are very important and necessary for our prayer on these hot summer days. They are set strategically in the sanctuary and in the church for the Sunday Eucharist. There is good movement of air flow throughout the church and one doesn't have to be

directly in front of the fan to feel the air. For this reason, I ask that no one move the fans and please watch the children. The fans are not to be played with and we can't always afford to fix them when they break nor can we always replace them. So moving them or touching them as little as possible will promote the longevity of their use and help all of us to be more comfortable praying at Eucharist on the weekend. Also, they can be moved during the week, but I ask that they stay in church and not be taken to the basement. Please remember the place for the fans and always return them to their proper place immediately when the event is over. Also, the extension cords that are attached to some of the fans are absolutely necessary in order to have a particular fan function from the place that we have positioned it and maintain a balanced air flow as mentioned above. Please, never disconnect these extension cords or remove them from the fan to which they are attached. Our prayer always gets top priority and we need these extension cords and fans for church. It is just not right, immediately before mass starts, to discover that the cords and fans are missing and cannot be used during our Your cooperation with this matter is most worship. appreciated.

Two More Things:
The cleanliness of our church, buildings and grounds is due to the wonderful work of our maintenance man and to the help of various volunteer groups that visit St. Leo and designated volunteers from our parish and



our partner parishes. But we really need the help of all of our parishioners to keep our place clean and always welcoming for others and ready to use when the next group arrives. Anytime someone sees that the pews need organizing or our parish library or a book needs to be returned, please don't wait to be asked, as the Nike commercial says: "Just do it!" Any time there is paper on the floor or trash in our parking lot, please pick it up and throw it away. Pride in our parish and caring for each other in this way are great ways to thank those who work so hard to help us keep our place in good and beautiful condition. Also, the servers' sacristy is always in need of attention. Surprisingly, the servers' albs seem to always fall to the floor! We are working on a solution for this but please anytime someone sees an alb or two or three or four on the floor, would you be so kind as to hang it up? An alb is the white robe that a server wears when serving mass. Lastly, we occasionally have safety concerns when doors are left unlocked or water is left running in the bathrooms. Whenever, there is a meeting of any kind, please designate someone to check all the doors and the bathrooms before leaving the building: water should be off, fans and lights off, anything moved returned to original spot, rooms used should be cleaned and ready for someone else to use and all doors locked. Finally, anything that is broken or needs repair should be reported to the parish office, the next day. We are so very blessed to have more activity happening in our parish than we have had in years. Like any family, we need to learn how to live together. Again, thank you so much for your cooperation in these concerns and for being the parish of St. Leo.
