# Father Bob's Ramblings

Now that we are in the sub-freezing cold of midwinter, all life around us seems to have slowed down quite a bit. Along with mid-winter also comes the Season of Lent. This year, Lent begins on next Wednesday, March 1<sup>st</sup>.

Although only a little more than a week away, it is not too soon to begin thinking about what mindset we might adopt for our spiritual practices for this season. Our Scripture readings this weekend seem to lay out a path we may want to consider.

Most of us want things to go our way. There are things we want. There are situations in which we hope to prevail. Sometimes we can arrange to make them happen. Sometimes other people suffer for it, but other times they benefit because our vision is actually quite good.

However, there are times our way is not God's way. We may not agree with God's way. We may think that God is making a mistake. We may think that our ways are better and that God should listen to us. But God has a plan, even though it may be a mysterious plan. It is a plan incomprehensible to humans, even if it is not like our plan.

God's words to Moses in our first reading: "Be holy, for I, the Lord, your God, am holy" and Jesus' words in the gospel: "Be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect" are words spoken to us as well. These might be difficult words to see as a plan, but they are truly a call for us to try to work on during Lent.

As we prepare for Lent, we might want to ask ourselves in whom and what do we put our trust. Can we be more accepting of God's plan by trusting more in God and giving up what keeps us from trusting in God's plan?
