
Father Bob's Ramblings

This weekend our Lenten Journey invites us turn from water to light as an image of baptism's renewal. While the Gospel passage of the man blind from birth is the clear center of today's teaching, the second reading, from Ephesians, speaks beautifully of those of us who are already baptized: "Now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light."

Saint Paul's challenge and the progressive "enlightenment" of the once-blind man are good reminders to us that baptism is really the beginning of a journey rather than the end. We are all baptized people, but like the blind man, we are still growing in our faith, still coming to understand what it means to be enlightened by Christ. The Prayer after Communion acknowledges our need to grow in that new sight, asking that God "illuminate our hearts with the splendor of your grace." We can never forget, of course, that the purpose of seeing the light is to become Christ's light in the world.

This past fall I sent out a letter to all of you, our parishioners, and presented to you a rather negative message about our parish financial health. I am happy to report to you that our financial situation is no longer in intensive care. But is slowly recovering.

Thanks to many of you who have heard my cry for help and either began to once again support the parish weekly or monthly and/or have increased your offertory donations. We are up to date on paying all our bills and have been able to put some money into savings. I hope we can continue in this positive direction and save our parish.
