Father Bob's Ramblings

As we gather this weekend, we continue to celebrate Easter. Even though the Easter cards are put away in the card shops and the Easter baskets and candy are all but gone, we still celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus. As a matter of fact, because Easter is so important, we will celebrate this great feast of feasts for 50 days! For more than twenty centuries, we still boldly announce to the world: Christ lives!

Liturgically, the "eight days" of Easter begin at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday and continue through today. Every day is seen as another Easter, to rejoice in the life, death and resurrection of Jesus. That is why all our prayers during this weekend's masses refer to today being Easter.

Saint Augustine refers to these eight days of Easter as "days of mercy and pardon," calling this Second Sunday of Easter as "the summary of the days of mercy." After his resurrection, Jesus took great care to show his apostles the wounds of his passion, especially the wound in his heart, the source from which flows the mercy poured out on humanity.

Since the year 2000, the Church has designated the final day of the Octave of Easter as the Sunday of Divine Mercy to celebrate the fact that Jesus still calls us to immerse ourselves in his mercy and love.

That loving mercy of Jesus is with us as we mourn the coming loss of our Parish Community. As we celebrated our Easter joy this past weekend, it was not hard to see the pain we all shared with one another. It is Jesus's merciful love that will help us make it through the next couple of months. As I receive more news about how this will all be worked out, I will, as always, share it with you.

I also want to thank all of you who have shown me care, support and love over the past two weeks since I had to share the news of our closing with you. It has meant an awful lot to me and has helped me get through my own pain.

I would like to thank all who shared in making our Holy Week and Easter celebrations so beautiful and prayerful; especially our choir, under the direction of Rouzan Gevorkian, who met every week to rehearse the music, our Readers and Eucharistic Ministers and our Servers.
