### Father Bob's Ramblings

On this Second Sunday of Easter, we continue to celebrate the joyfulness of Easter Day. Even though Easter cards have been replaced by Mother's Day cards in the stores and most of the Easter candy and chocolate bunnies have been eaten, we continue to celebrate Easter until the feast of Pentecost on June  $4^{th}$ . Easter is such an important day for our faith that we celebrate it for 50 days. So, if you hear me pray that today is still Easter Day. I'm not making a mistake. It still *IS* Easter Day!

Each weekend during the Easter Season, we hear in our first reading from the Acts of the Apostles. These readings give us a view into the inner life of the young church. The community's inner life is the basis for its public witness and an important factor in attracting converts. Those who joined the community, like us, had never seen the Risen Jesus in person, but they saw him in *persons*, in the lives of those who had already joined the community. And, that is still how the Faith continues to be spread: the witness we give of our belief in the presence of the Risen Lord Jesus by the way we live our lives. THAT should make us stop and ask ourselves if our lives really tell others about what we believe.

We also hear how there are four characteristics that mark that first Christian Community and still reflect what characterizes us: the Apostles' teaching, fellowship, the breaking of bread, and common prayer. To that list, we might also add "mutual forgiveness and understanding."

AS for the *SPRINKLING*...Each weekend when we gather to worship during Easter time, we begin by being sprinkled with the Easter Water rather than confessing our sins. This Rite is a reminder that the gift of our faith was given to us when we were *washed* in the waters of Baptism. I get smiles and smirks (and other things) as I remind us all that we were *washed* with water as I shower us each week.

Finally, I want to thank all who helped make our *Triduum* so prayerful and beautiful: our music director, Rouzan; our choir; our trumpeter; our servers; those who helped to clean and decorate the church, any anyone else who helped.
