Could only happen with everyone's joining together.

Father Bob's Ramblings

Attached to this weekend's Bulletin is a copy of the Parish's Annual Financial Report for the fiscal year of July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017. The report was reviewed and approved by our Parish Auditors, Paul Filippone and Michael Pagliaro; our Parish Trustees, Ed Eramian and Carol Marrocco; and our Financial Council members, Robert Civetti, Frank DiRaimo, Frank Manni, Robert Montagano, and Paul Pecchia. I would like to take this opportunity to thank each of them for their time and energy throughout the year in reviewing our finances and advising me about our financial matters.

Although our fiscal health is a little better than last year, our parish is still struggling to maintain our financial stability. Our weekly offertory collection is down \$2,000 from last year and our monthly collection is down by \$1,000. The regular income from these collections is what we need to rely on to support ourselves. Summertime continues to be a time when our cash flow does not meet our incoming bills. As I have so often said, our parish fundraisers are meant to be supplemental money that should be put aside for special needs. This year's parish functions were \$4,000 better than last year's, allowing us to build up our savings to \$13,000, still not enough of a backup.

Luckily, our expenses could be reduced by \$10,000. This is due to a bare-bones budget created by the members of the Finance Council. Many of our budgeted items and dictated by the diocese and therefore cannot be lowered. We need to realize that unlike other parishes, we do not have a parish secretary or bookkeeper nor a custodian. If it were not for my taking on these responsibilities and the time of a very few volunteers, we would need to be paying people professional salaries for these positions.

Of the 385 active households only 132 financially support the parish. I wish to thank all who are actively supporting the parish on a regular basis. You are carrying the financial burden for the rest. I am asking those who are not regularly supporting the parish to please try to do so and if any of you can increase your weekly offertory, please consider doing so. The future of our parish is in your hands.
