### Father Bob's Ramblings

In today's second reading, we begin a series of readings from Saint Paul's First Letter to the Thessalonians. This is the earliest of Saint Paul's writings. It was addressed to a community eagerly awaiting the triumphant return of the risen Christ at the end of time. But, the community's faith was wavering in the meantime. Saint Paul speaks of their "endurance", especially in light of their harassment at the hands of the Jewish people. He goes on to exhort them to adhere to the teachings of Jesus in the gospel.

Two thousand years later, we, too, need to be exhorted to adhere to the teachings of Jesus in the gospel. We, too, are often harassed by people in our society who think we are a "little crazy" because we do what we do because of our faith. We need to try to hang on as well, strengthened by the Eucharist, which offers us a participation in the life of Jesus and strengthens us as we live out the teachings of Jesus.

However, as many of you have mentioned to me, less and less people are coming to celebrate the Eucharist and be strengthened in their life of faith. Our attendance at weekend Mass continues to shrink each week. Our average attendance is around 120 or less. I will be monitoring the numbers for the next few weeks. If attendance continues to go down, we will soon need to return to two masses each weekend: 5:00 PM on Saturdays and 9:00 AM on Sundays. I know that I am "preaching to the choir," but I feel I need to be honest with you.

The re-construction of our chimneys began this past Monday. The rectory chimney was knocked down and rebuilt from the roof-line up. Next will be the rebuilding of the church chimney, which will entail more work. I am planning to use the money from the Annual Bazaar to pay for these repairs.

And, just a reminder that next week we begin our Annual Collection. Please try to be as supportive as possible.
