### Father Bob's Ramblings

Wednesday and Thursday of this week the Church celebrates two very reflective days in our liturgical year: The Solemnity of All Saints and the Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed (All Souls).

The Solemnity of All Saints, a holy day of obligation, honors all those who, we believe, are in the eternal presence of God. It commemorates all those who, in some way, mirrored the Paschal Mystery of Christ in their lives of faith. These are God's holy and faithful ones who lived their faith in profound ways. Some were great leaders of nations; others were holy ministers of the Lord. Still others were married and single men and women who lived Christ's Gospel message in the ordinariness of their daily lives. All of them are examples to us of how we need to live our lives of faith.

All Souls Day commemorates all those who have died and who, we pray, may one day join the saints in the heavenly kingdom. These are the faithful departed who we pray to God, in his great love and mercy, takes to himself. On this day, we pray for all the dead. We pray that He welcomes them into the banquet of heaven with all the saints in glory.

Masses for All Saints Day will be at 7:30 AM and 5:00 PM on Wednesday and the Mass for All Souls will be at 7:30 AM on Thursday.

Let us take a few moments during these days to remember all those whom we loved who have gone before us. Let us remember how they lived their lives and may have been examples of faith and love to us.

I'm happy to report that the re-building of the rectory chimney is completed without any delaying problems. The repairing of the church chimney is also finished. The other masonry repairs to the front and side church steps and some crumbling pieces on the church will be put off until the spring.
