The shelter was 'manned' by a team of volunteers coming from Holy Rosary, Our Lady of Mercy, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, St. James, St. Johns, St. Luke's, and St. Mark's. The residents of the shelter were very, very thankful for all the kind and caring volunteers. The shelter will return again March 9<sup>th</sup> thru March 23<sup>rd</sup> to St. John the Baptist. People have begun to sign up for March. First shift (7pm-11pm) is complete. Our dinner schedule is complete, however, we are still in need of many food items, such as: coffee, coffee creamer, sugar, hot cocoa packets, cereal, packaged oatmeal, fruit, juices, and napkins. In addition, we are always in need of warm socks, gloves, hats, underwear, and the most needed toiletries are: toothpaste (small, personal size), tooth brushes, and small deodorant.
