The Patron Saints of Music:  
Praying the song on our lips:  
Saints pray for us!!

We have all seen stained glass windows and artists' renderings of Saint Cecilia playing the organ, and Saint Gregory composing chant melodies as the dove of the Holy Spirit whispers in his ear.

Alas, even a quick dip into history will tell us that St. Cecilia did not invent the organ and that St. Gregory probably did not compose the chants that bear his name. Indeed, we cannot be sure that music's patron saints were even musicians!!

And yet, Cecilia and Gregory are surely the right patrons for music. An antiphon for the feast of St. Cecilia describes how on her wedding day, Cecilia heard the musician striking up their tunes, and she began to sing, not with her lips but with her heart. And Gregory is "great" not because of his musical talent but because of his dedication to renewal of the church and to evangelization: it was he who sent St. Augustine of Canterbury to bring the gospel to the British Isles.

Music's patron saints are not, then, an organist and a composer but a mystic and an apostle. Cecilia and Gregory remind us that we must---to echo the words of Paul Inwood's beautiful hymn "Take Christ to the World"---pray the song on our lips. We must *live* the music we make. Each of us is called to be a mystic *and* an apostle, and good liturgical music strikes a delicate balance, recognizing and maintaining the tension between internal and external, that is, music happens both inside and outside of us, as we raise our own voices as individuals in a community, to join in the song that surrounds us!

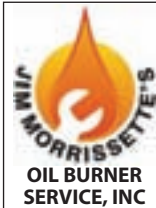
