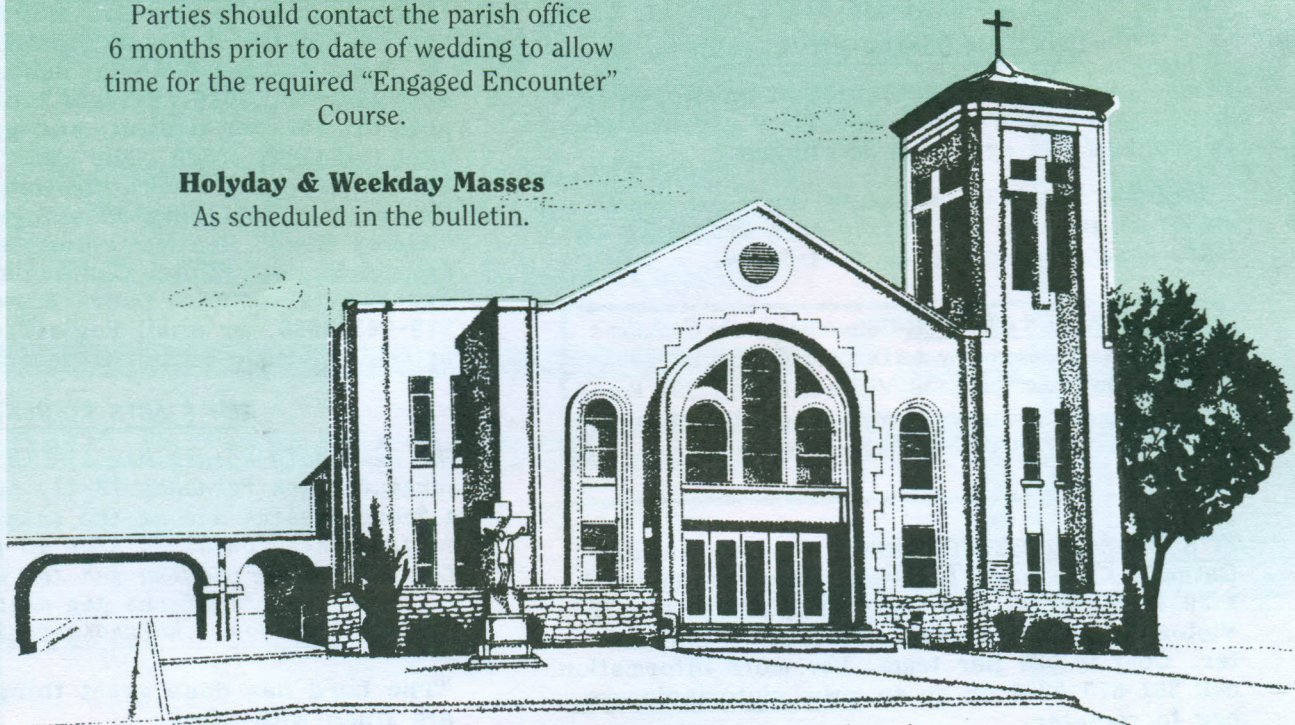

In the synagogue where Jesus preached His first sermon, He said that His coming would result in a revolution that would bless the poor, release the captives, and bring liberty to the oppressed. Worshippers hearing Him were confronted with the radical changes He came to begin. That worship service was hazardous to the status quo, a threat to the hazed past.
