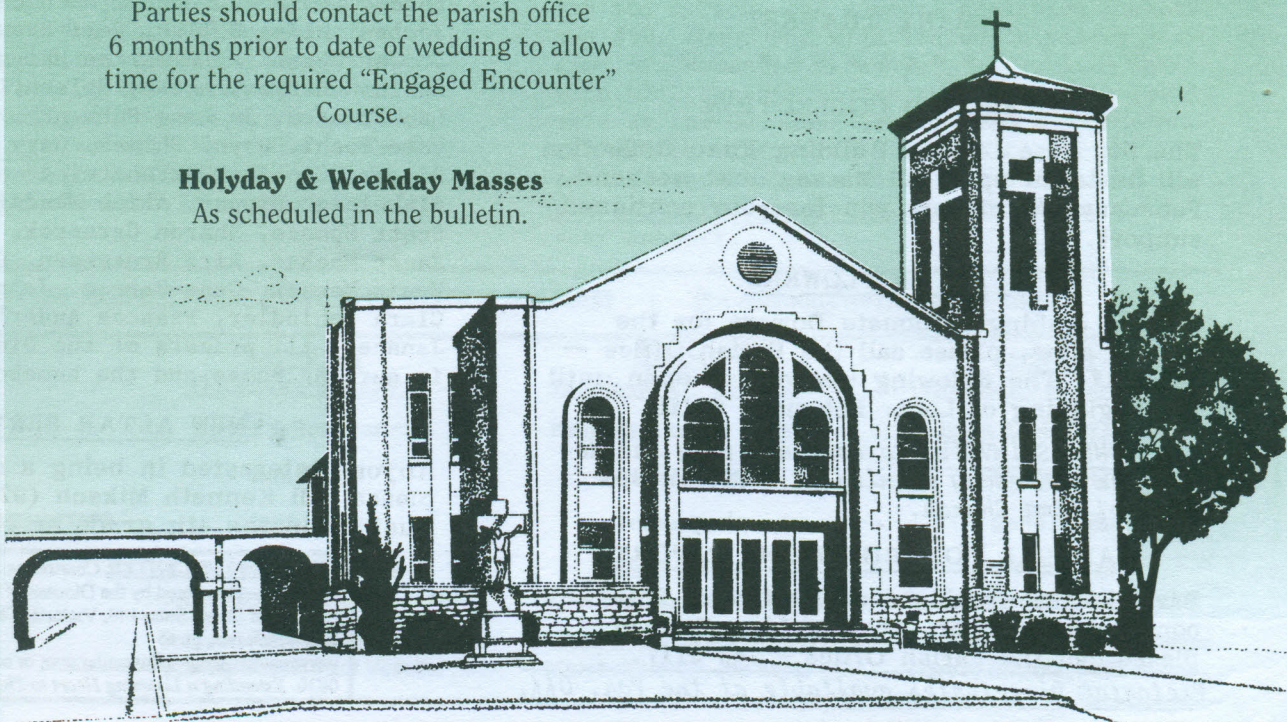

FROM the PASTOR

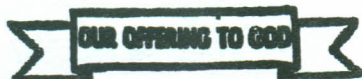

FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION

On Thursday, February 2, the feast of the Presentation of Our Lord in the Temple by His Mother Mary, candles will be blessed which you intend to use in your home. Place your candles on the tables in the sanctuary, and they will be blessed along with the other candles.

If you do not have candles for your home, you may obtain these at the Parish Office.

It is our Catholic custom and tradition to bless the candles on this day. This tradition is based on the 10th century practice of solemn blessing of the candles, which were used in the procession on the Feast of the Presentation. The procession with candles refers to Simeon's proclamation that "Christ is the Light revealed to the nations" and represents, in a way, the Presentation in the Temple.
