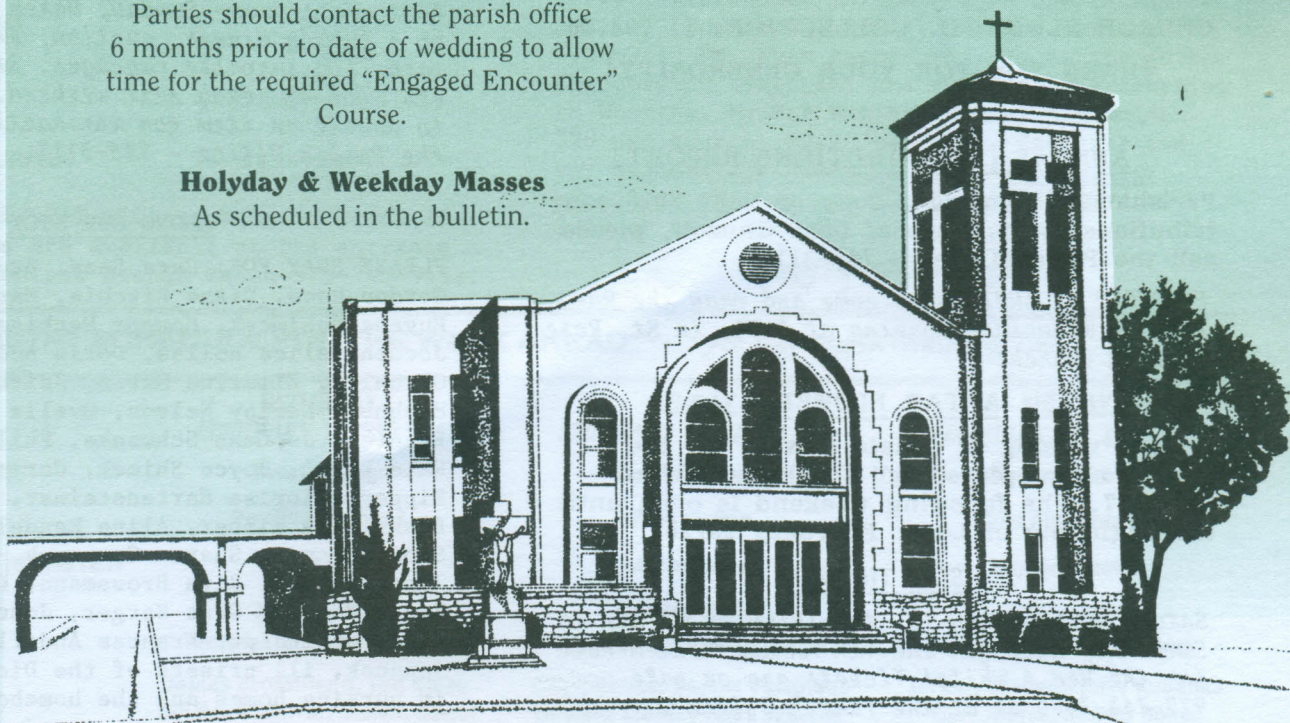

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

To become mature human beings, to progress spiritually, to become loving people in the likeness of Christ, even to enjoy some peace and happiness in this life, we must become entirely free of bitterness. Indignation, resentment, the desire to "get even", and to live in hope that people are punished for their crimes, can keep us upset and tear us apart. As long as we remain unsettled by anger and critical of others, we will not even be able to pray properly. Prayer only works when it is filled with love. The more love, the more power in prayer. The opposite is true. The less love, the less power in prayer. How much love can there be in our prayers when we hate, when we are critical, when we are judgmental, when we are angry with someone? The answer is: Not much!

Jesus tells us that our holiness must exceed that of people like the scribes and Pharisees who merely keep the externals of the law. We are not only to keep from killing people. We are not to even be angry with anyone. Large order! I suspect we all have a long way to go to fill it. So let's get started. Let's really get serious about loving one another, from deep down within our souls.
