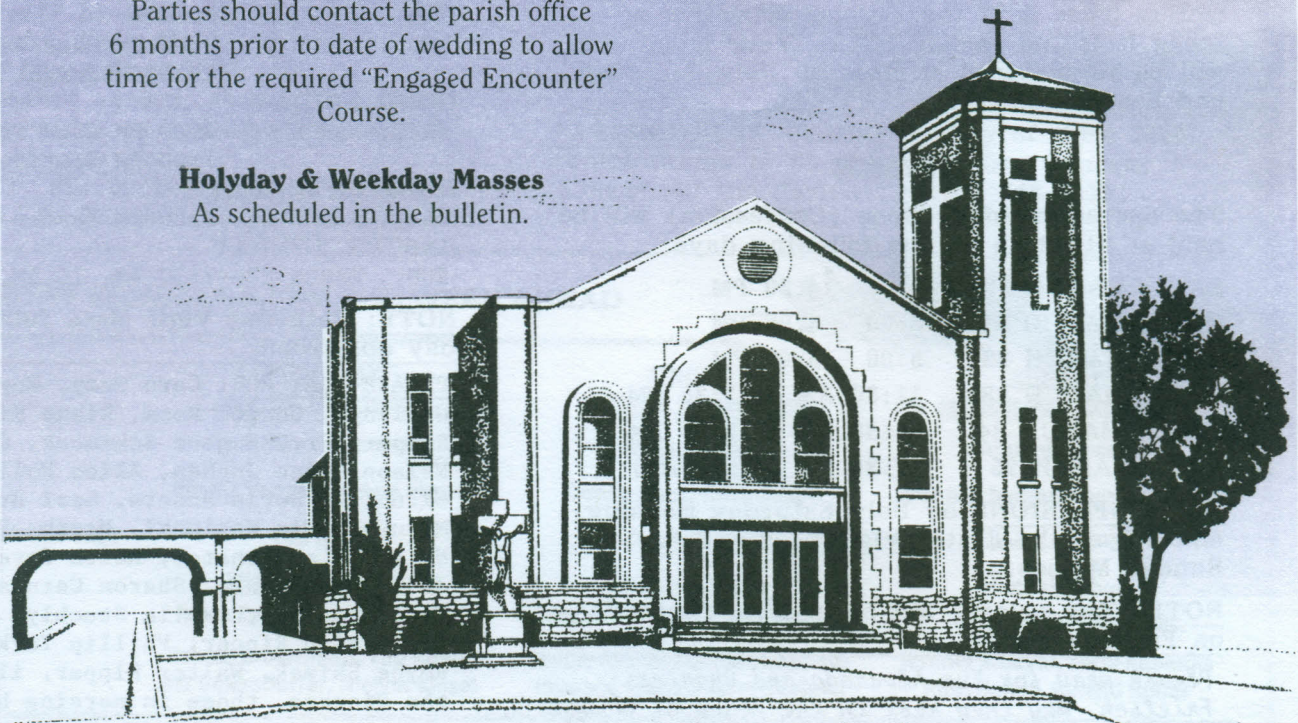

Next Saturday, March 19, palms for Palm Sunday will be blessed. The blessing of palms will take place at 4:45 PM, in front of St. Rose of Lima School. If you are planning to come to the 5:00 PM Mass, please come 15 minutes earlier. Following the blessing of palms, we will go in procession to the church. There will be no blessing of palms before the Sunday Masses.

As a reminder, it is important that your old palms from last year MAY NOT merely be discarded in the trash. Since they are blessed (sacramentals), they are to be burnt and the ashes placed in the ground. (Other blessed objects not consumable by fire are to be buried when their usefulness expires). Or, if you prefer, we will take care of your old palms for you. Just bring them in the altar servers sacristy or bring them to the Parish Office.
