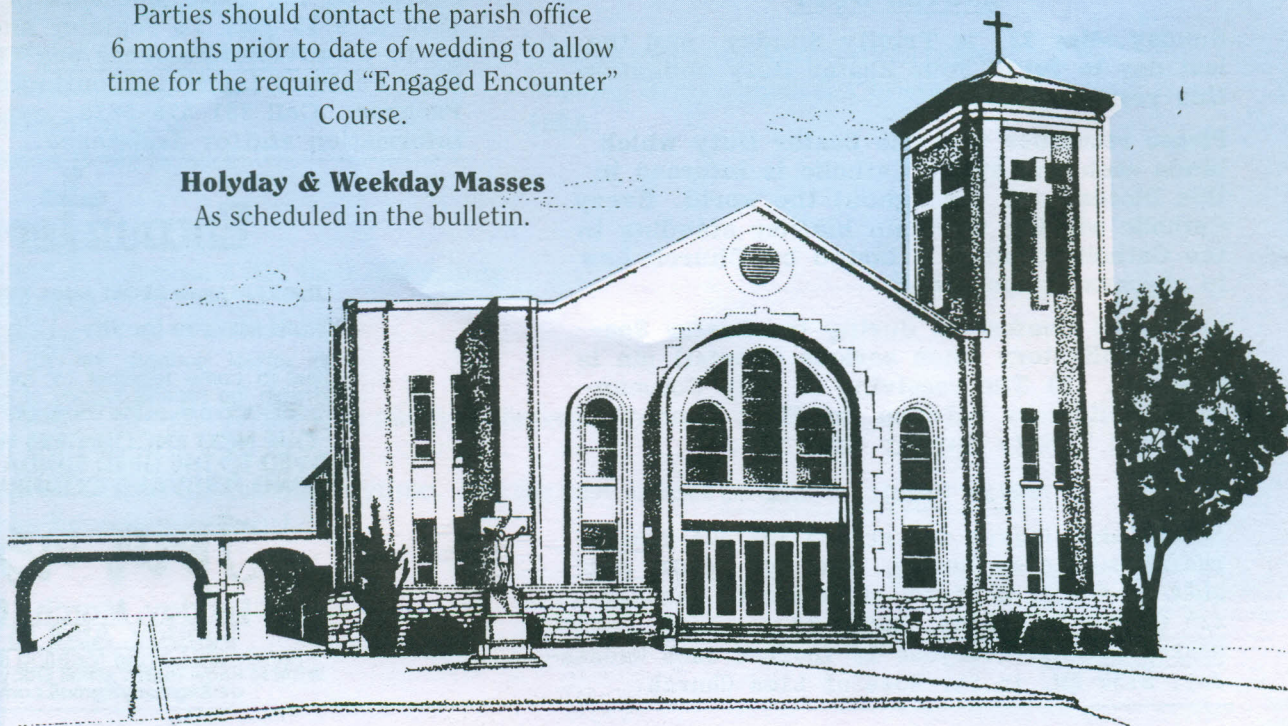

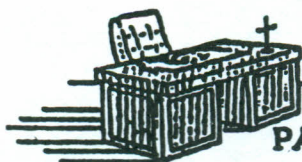

Dear Ladies of St. Rose of Lima Parish,


