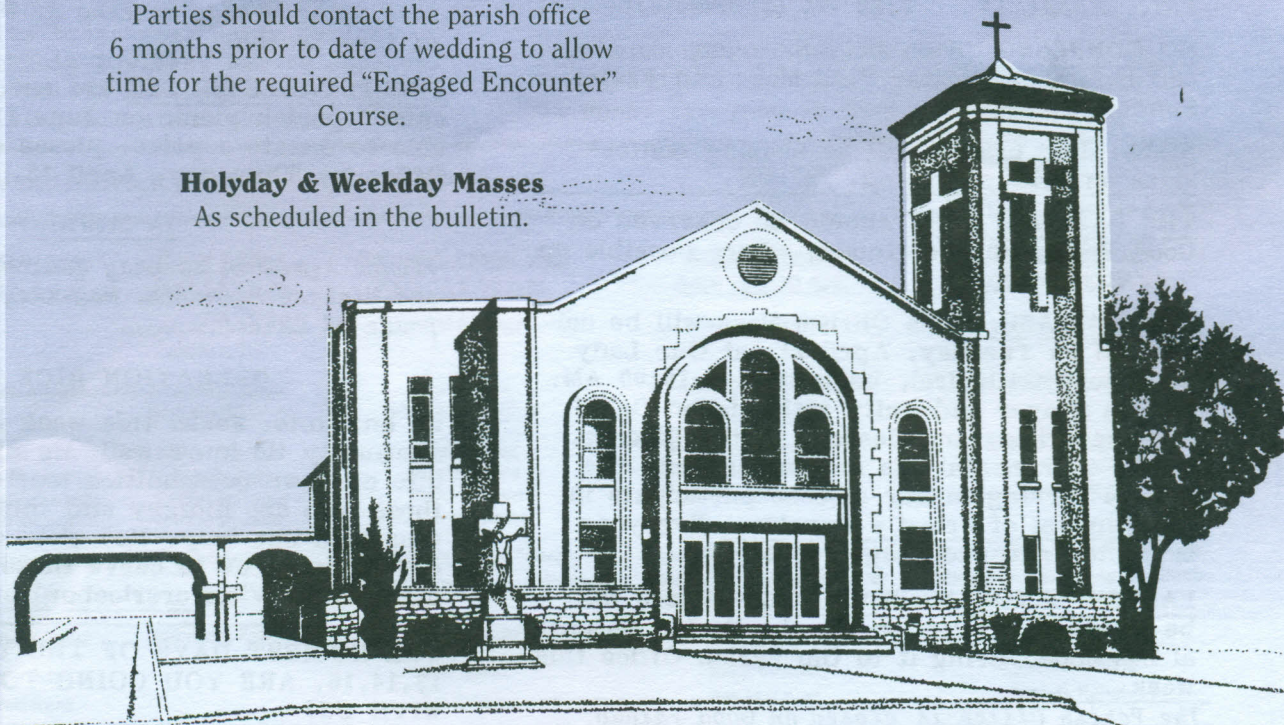

THE PASCHAL FAST should be observed on Good Friday and continued; where possible on Holy Saturday.

CHRISM MASS: The Chrism Mass will be celebrated on Tuesday, April 11, at Our Lady of Victory Cathedral, beginning at 10:00 AM. Join in prayer and unity with Bishop Cahill, and the priests and deacons of the Diocese, as the sacramental oils are blessed and the priests serving in our diocese participate in the Renewal of Priestly Promises. Everyone is invited and encouraged to attend.

EASTER MEMORIAL ENVELOPE - There will be no special collection for the Easter Memorial Envelope. Bring it to the Parish Office this week.

The Parish Office is closed on Good Friday.

Easter Triduum

TRIDUUM means three days. The three days of Easter are Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. Lent ends on Holy Thursday when the Easter Triduum begins. This is the final time of preparation for Easter. On each of the three days we celebrate Jesus' death and resurrection. Each day focuses in its own special way on this single mystery.

HOLY THURSDAY ADORATION

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will take place after Holy Thursday Mass until midnight. Families whose names begin with certain letters are asked to be present at the assigned times: 7:00-8:00 PM - S,T,U,V,; 8:00-9:00 PM - W,Z,A,B; 9:00-10:00 PM - C,D,E,F,G; 10:00-11:00 PM - H,J,K,L,M; 11:00 PM-12:00AM N,O,P,Q,R.
