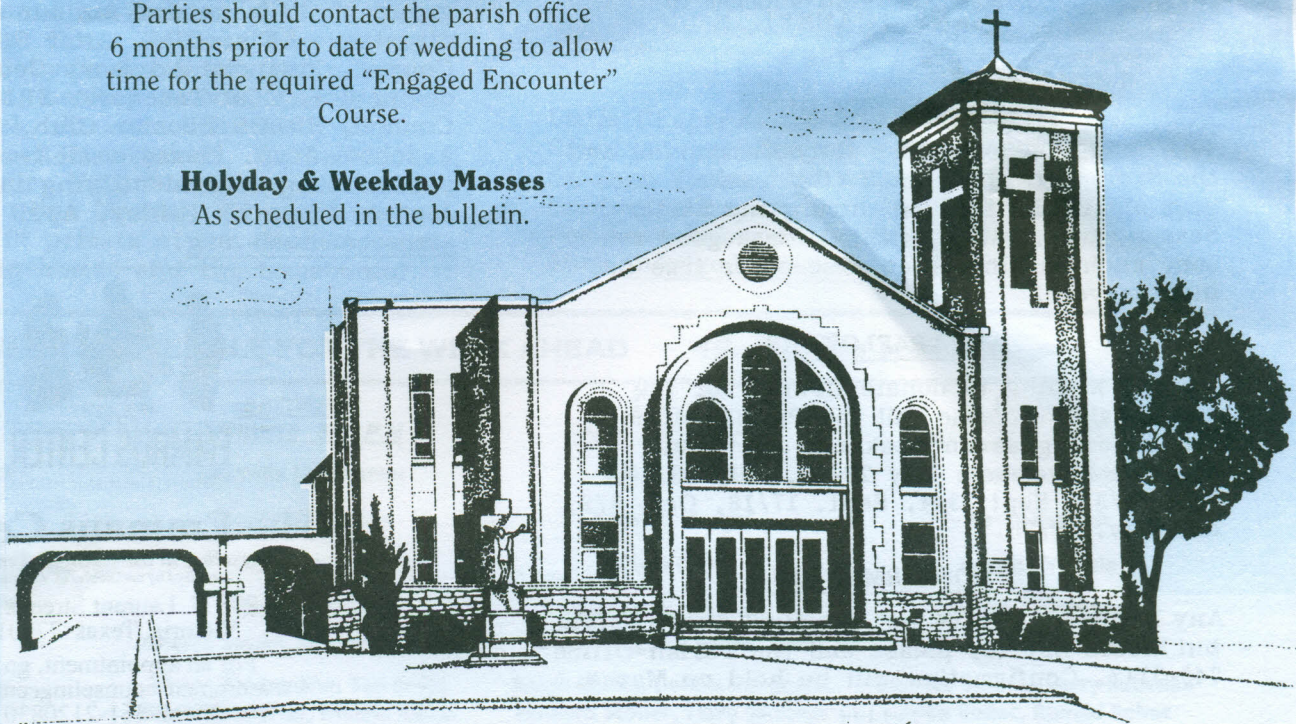

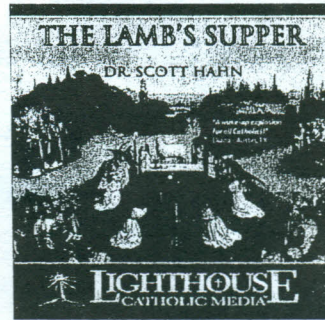
PARISH PICNIC MEETING
