

SOCIETA SHIE MOSE

This fourth Sunday of Easter offers us the image of the Good Shepherd.

John's gospel puts a particular twist to the image. The usual images of the shepherd show the caregiver going out and seeking what was lost, or even going out in protection of the sheep. SECOND COLLECTION




