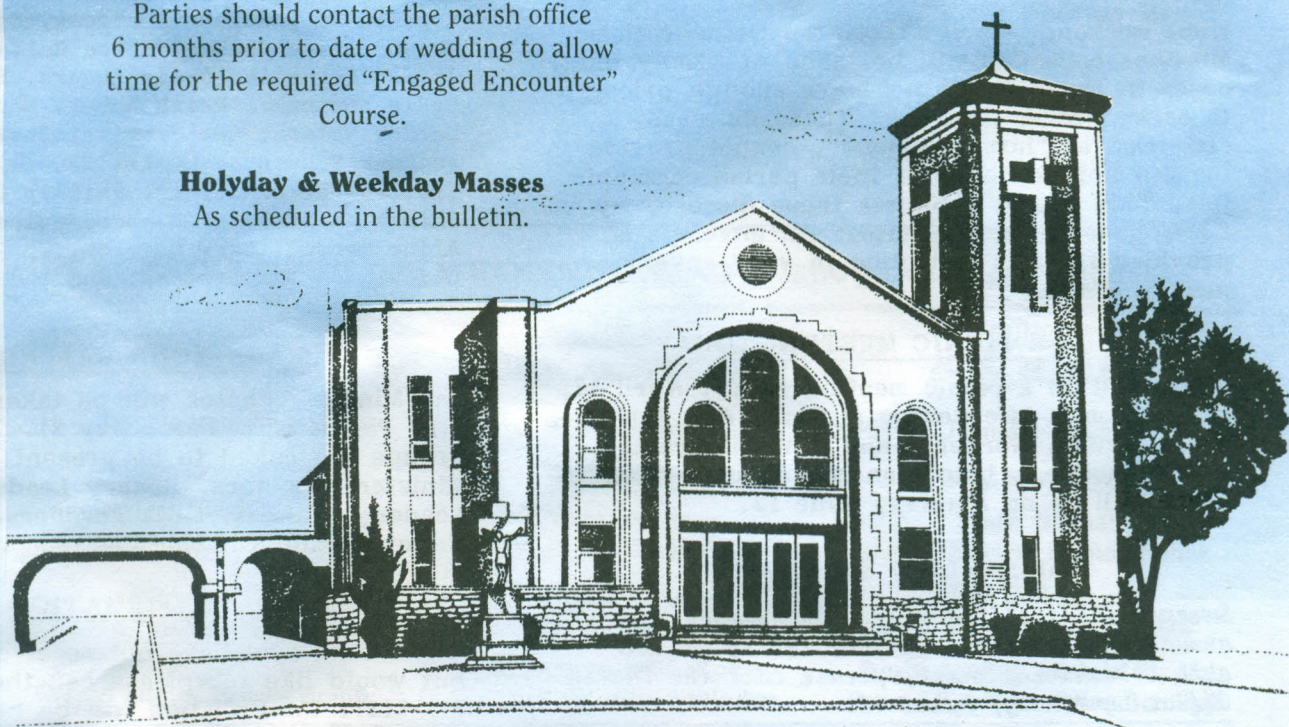

FROM THE PASTOR

Congratulations

Blessings and Congratulations to Father Tim on the 45th anniversary of his priestly ordination on Saturday, April 23. We ask God's blessings for him on this day and in days and years to come.

This fourth Sunday of Easter offers us the image of the Good Shepherd.

John's gospel puts a particular twist to the image. The usual images of the shepherd show the caregiver going out and seeking what was lost, or even going out in protection of the sheep. Today we are told that the sheep know the voice of the shepherd -- that there is a very deep and personal relationship between the two. The sheep hear and know the voice of the One who cares for them.

This gospel presents us with the challenge and the question: How well do we know that voice? Do we give ourselves the opportunity to listen to it? Have we taken our relationship for granted? God who has fashioned us and knows us, also wants us to be in relationship with Him. How much do we give to make the relationship work?



Perhaps the challenge for us is to give ourselves time to listen, to be quiet, and to hear Jesus' voice call to us once again.
