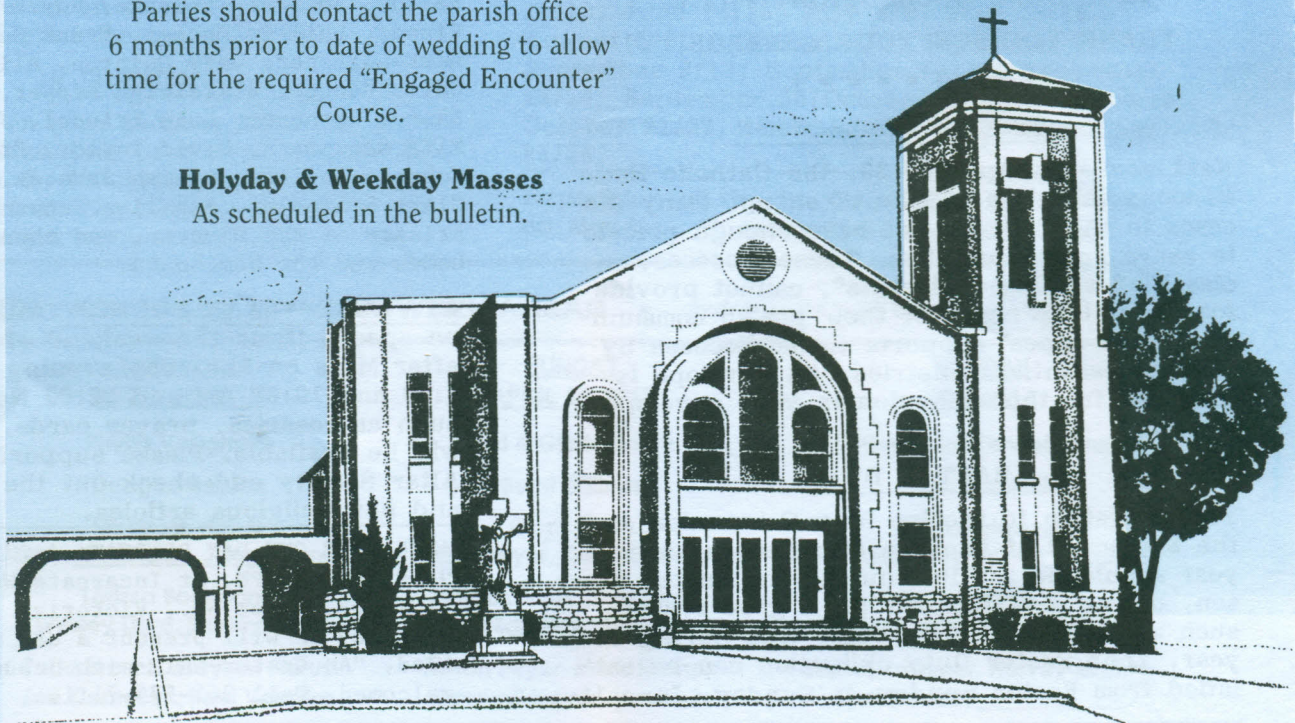

Think of the disciples asleep on the Mount of Transfiguration or snoozing in the Garden of Gethsemane. Remember the forehead smacking revelation for two weary travelers on the road to Emmaus. Scripture is littered with latecomers, some of whom steal the show.

Like Thomas in this week's reading, he's out when the big revelation in the upper room happens. And it's his natural belief at the disciples "tall tale" that teaches us a great lesson about faith. Centuries after that phenomenal Passover week we're latecomers too, faced with the same challenger of believing without seeing. We need that image of Jesus accepting Thomas in his moment of doubt to reassure us in these distant, darker hours.

- 1) Feed the hungry. 2) Give drink to the thirsty. 3) Clothe the naked. 4) Visit the imprisoned. 5) Shelter the homeless. 6) Visit the sick. 7) Bury the dead.

The spiritual works of mercy also have to do with personal relationships.

- 1) Correct those who need it. 2) Teach the illiterate. 3) Give advice to those who need it. 4) Comfort those who suffer. 5) Be patient with others. 6) Forgive those who hurt you. 7) Pray for others.
