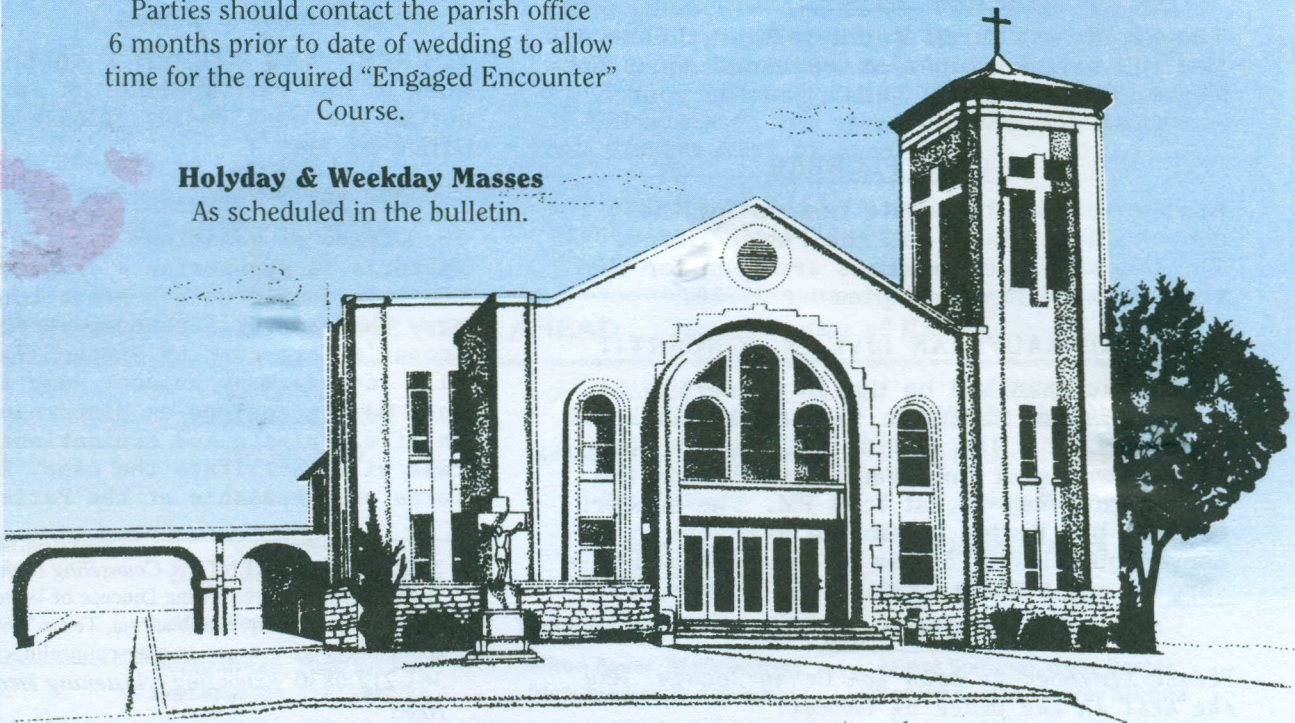

From the Pastors Desk

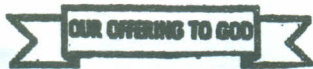

DAVID KAUFFMAN LIVE IN CONCERT!!

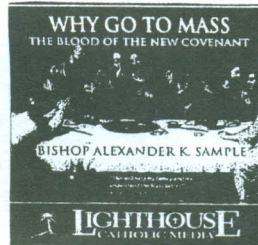
