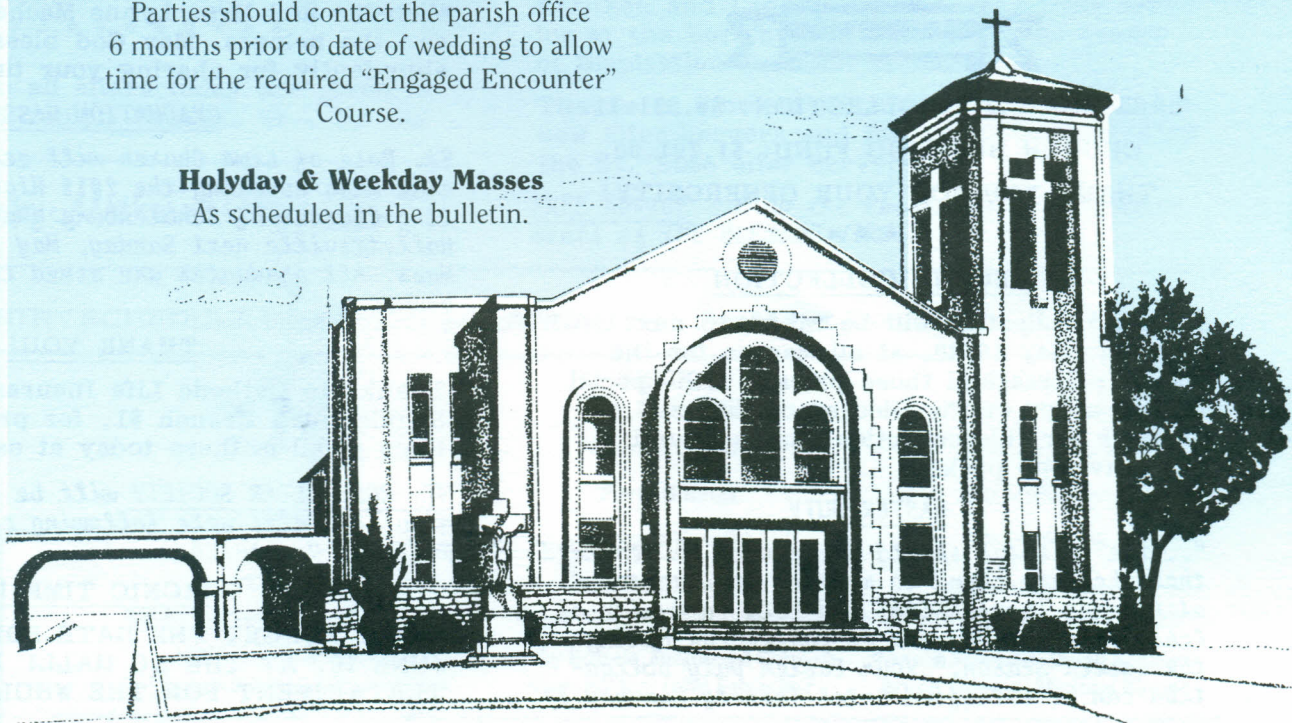

From the Pastor's Desk

The forty days that Jesus spent with His disciples after the resurrection must have seemed so short. There was so much Jesus had to tell and so much they had to learn, even after all the time they had spent with Him before. We can almost picture their meetings after Easter whenever He would come to be with them. Can't you see them jockeying for position to see Him, to hear Him, perhaps even to touch Him? Just the miracle of our Lord's living presence after His crucifixion that terrible Friday on Calvary was enough to absorb their attention completely now. But then came that fortieth day after Easter when Jesus took them to the mountain and was taken from their sight. This was another momentous day in the lives of all who had decided to follow this Jesus of Nazareth.

We can readily imagine that the ascension of Jesus was a very difficult time for the disciples. They saw it as the final earthly separation from the Master who was so special to them. There was a deep and peaceful conviction that now they had to carry on and expand the work Jesus had begun. To speak about the kingdom of God and to witness to Jesus, not only in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, but to the ends of the earth--these were now their task, and it came in the form of a clear mandate--"Go into the whole world and proclaim the Gospel to every creature." As His followers we, too, are given the mandate to proclaim the Good News and to witness to the Lord's real presence.
