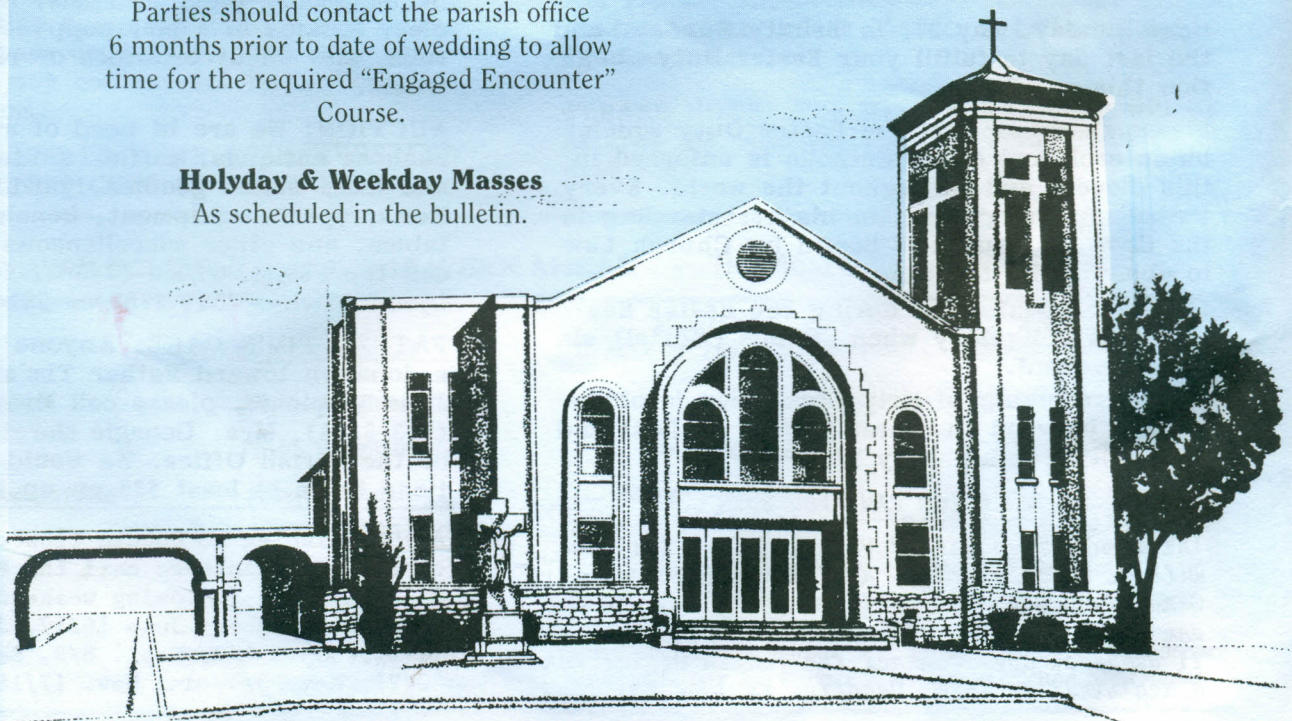

Next Sunday, May 27, is Trinity Sunday, and the last day to fulfill your Easter Duty obligation this year.

Please remember that the Easter Duty which binds each and every Catholic is enforced in this diocese and throughout the world. Every Catholic wishing to retain his/her standing in the Catholic Church is bound by Church Law to observe the following:

- 1) Annual Confession during the Easter Season is obligatory when serious (mortal) sin is involved.
- 2) The receiving of Holy Communion is obligatory between the First Sunday of Lent and Trinity Sunday (May 27).

SWEEPSTAKES TICKETS: Please try to buy or sell all your tickets. If more tickets are needed, please come to the Parish Office. You may return your sold tickets to the Parish Office, or put them in the collection basket. If it is before or after office hours, please use the mail drop located to the left of the Parish Office door. This year we have 61 prizes. Our sincere thanks to the contributors of the prizes, and to Herzik's Milk and Grain for donating the printing cost of the tickets. Please check the work roster to see where you are scheduled to work and the changes made to the Picnic. If your name is not listed, but can help, please contact the Parish Office.

EACH FAMILY is asked to bring two baked items--cakes or kolaches. Pickles are also needed. Please try to label your cakes so that the workers will know what flavor is available.

COUNTRY STORE: All parishioners are asked to bring baked goods, home canned goods, fancy work and handmade articles, garden fresh vegetables and fruits, nuts, yard eggs, homemade noodles, bread, pot plants and surprise packages for children (gift wrapped and value of package marked on outside of package). Children's surprise packages should have a value of 25¢ to \$1.00. No adult surprise packages this year. More home canned goods and plants are needed. These items can be taken to the Parish Office before the picnic or to the KC Hall that morning.


