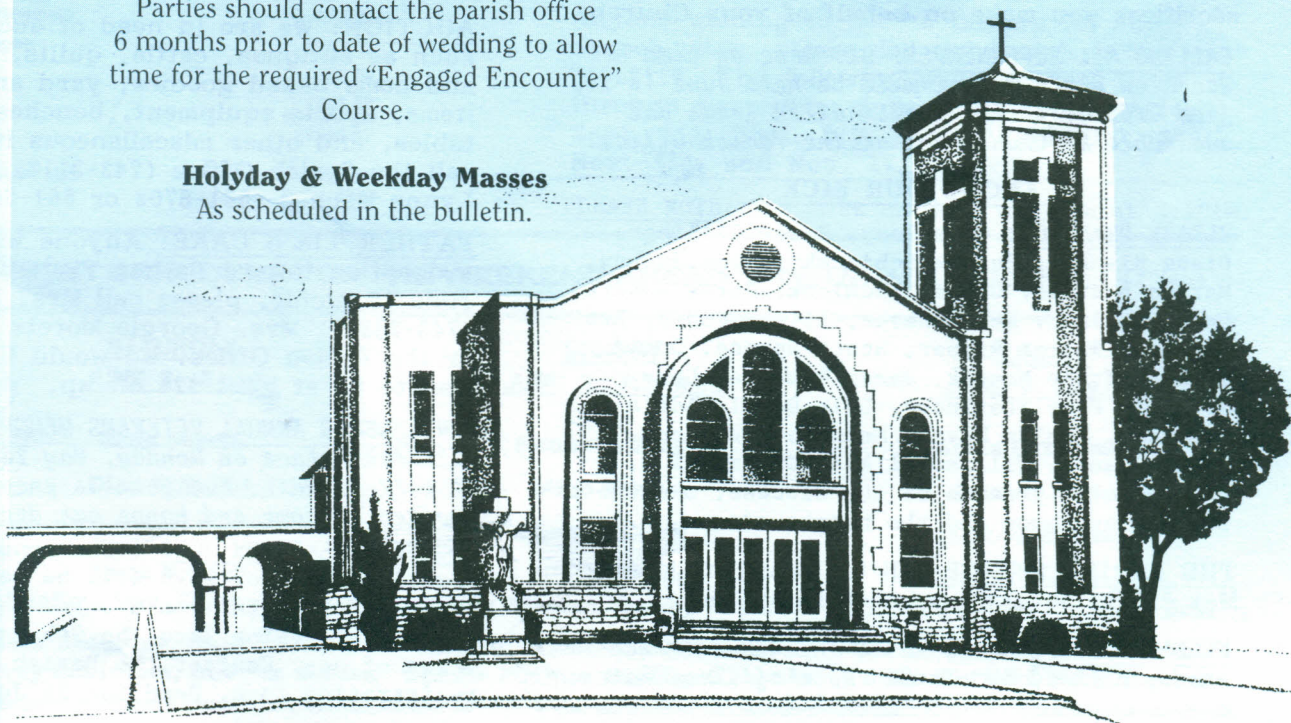

SWEEPSTAKES TICKETS: Please try to buy or sell all your tickets. If more tickets are needed, please come to the Parish Office. You may return your sold tickets to the Parish Office, or put them in the collection basket. If it is before or after office hours, please use the mail drop located to the left of the Parish Office door.

EACH FAMILY is asked to bring two baked items--cakes or kolaches. Pickes are also needed. Please try to label your cakes so that the workers will know what flavor is available.




