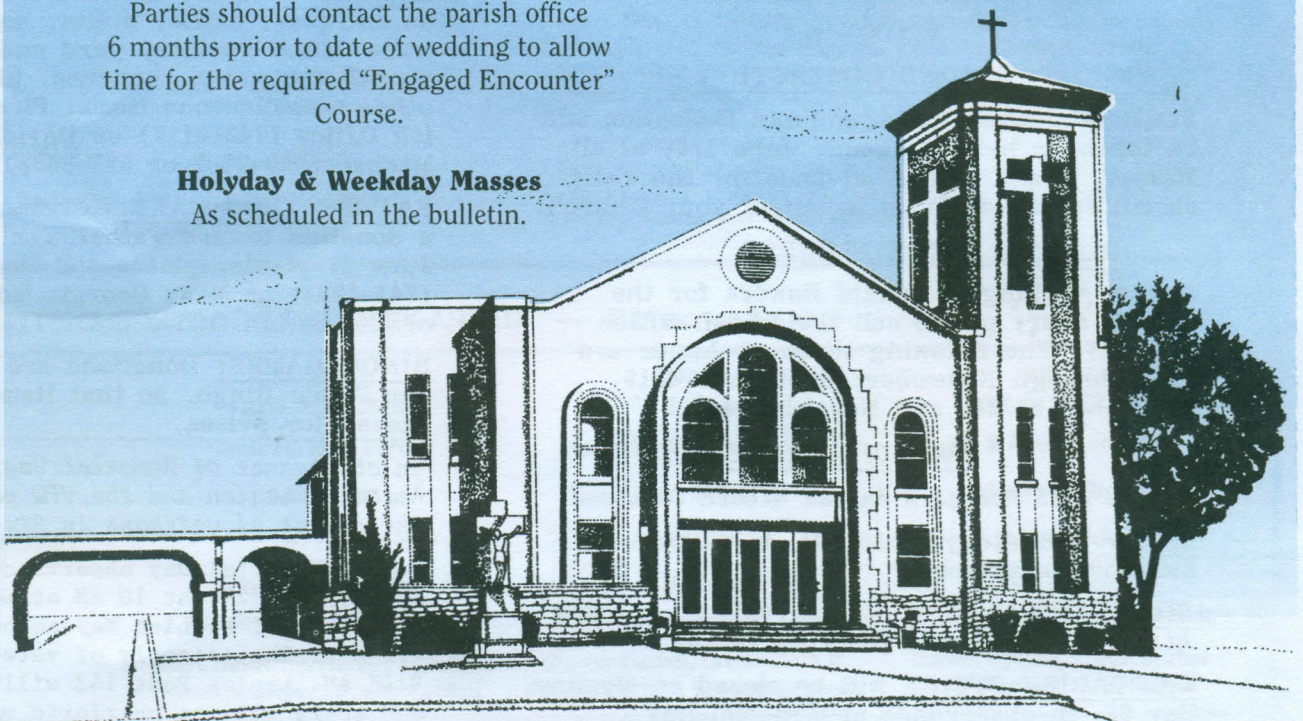

## From the Pastor

Compromise. It's a word that evokes an instinctive response. Hooray! We shout when enemies compromise for peace. Boo! We hiss when a respected leader compromises their ethics. But even when compromise is misused, we fiercely defend our right to that tiny bit of flexibility. It isn't that we don't want to follow rules or hold the line, we just like a little "fudge factor" when things get too uncomfortable.

Compromise wasn't a word Jesus had much to do with. His call was direct and unarguable. When people squirmed or waffled, Jesus simply held the standard higher, just as in today's Gospel. Ordered to gather on the mountain, Jesus gave the disciples direct marching orders: Go to all the nations! Make disciples and baptize! Get out there and tell people about God.

There wasn't any room for compromise on that mountainside and there still isn't any for His disciples today. We've been given clear instructions with no room to quibble. The question is, are we following or fudging?

**SWEEPSTAKES TICKETS:** Please try to buy or sell all your tickets. If more tickets are needed, please come to the Parish Office. If it is before or after office hours, please use the mail drop located to the left of the Parish Office door.
