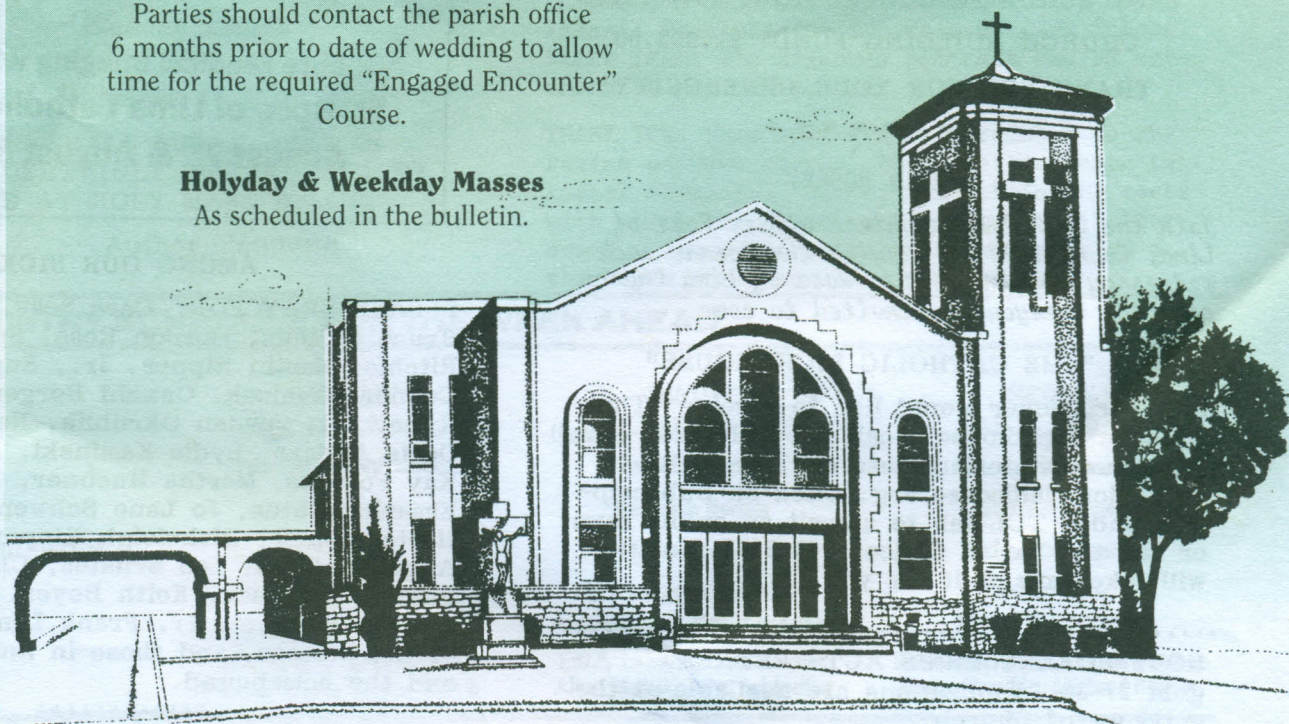

Try a little experiment next time you are out at a busy restaurant. Just listen to what the people around you in other booths and tables are discussing. You will hear everything from how the children are doing to how the stock market's doing to how the presidential candidates are faring. We have no difficulty thinking of things to talk about when we are around friends.

Why does the subject of our living relationship with Christ seem to be such a seldom heard topic? Is our discovery of the life changing power of Christ more embarrassing than sharing the latest discoveries in cancer treatment? Either we aren't convinced of the joy and power of sharing our witness, or we are more controlled by listening to our fears of rejection than pleasing our Lord.

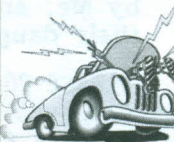
