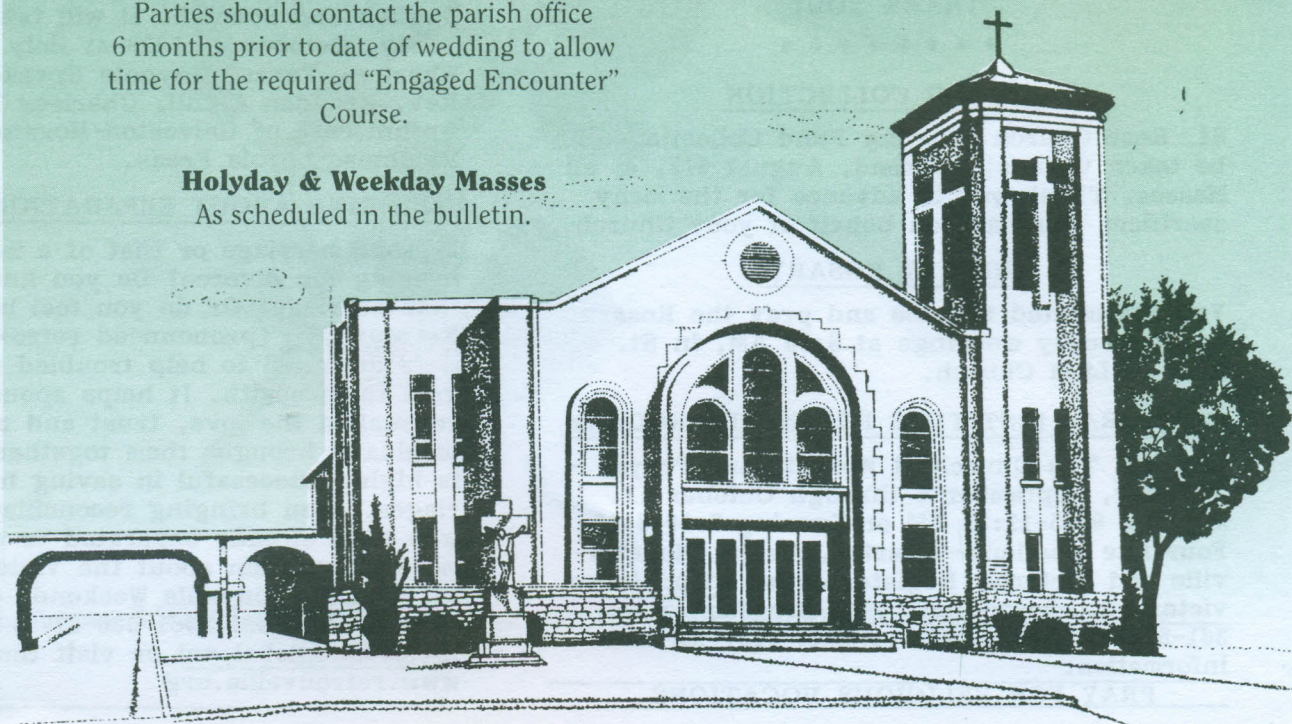

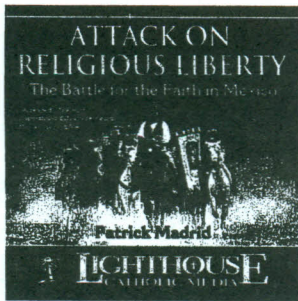
CCD Registration will be held on Wednesday, August 10, from 5:30 to 7:00 PM, in the St. Rose Family Life Center.
