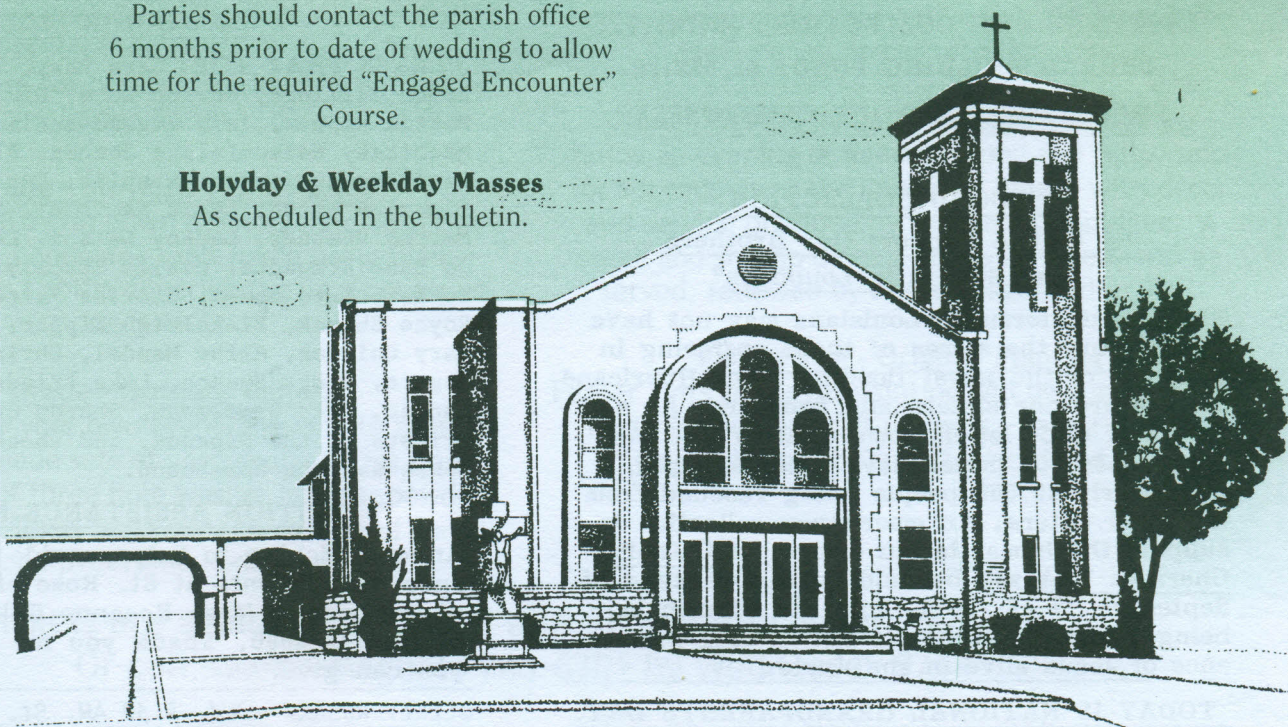

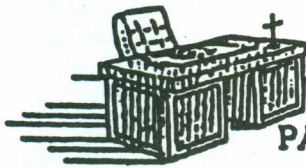

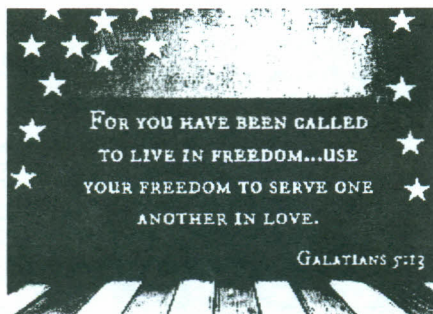


News from your Parish School
