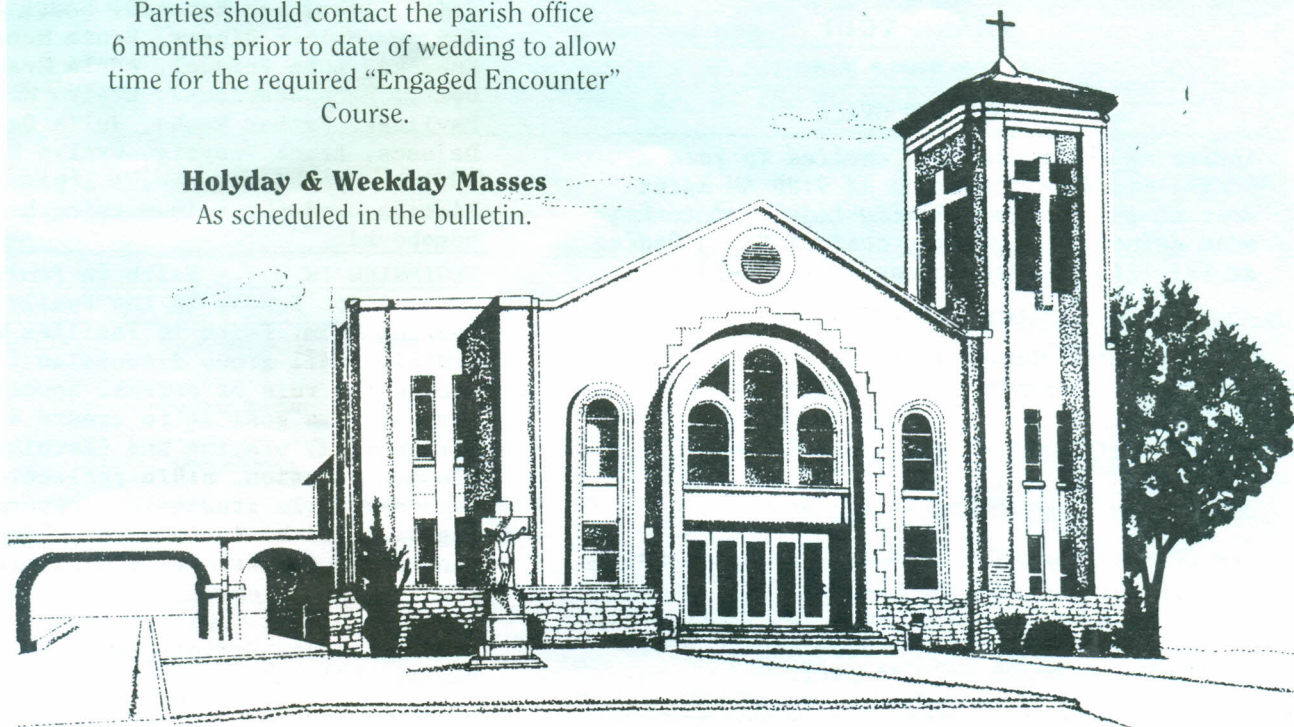

In the first part of the Gospel passage, James and John ask that Jesus assure them a place of honor and prestige in the "kingdom" He is going to bring about. Their question reveals that they have a very limited and partial understanding of Jesus' mission, as well as a lust for earthly power and glory. This request by James and John provides Jesus an opportunity to once again predict His suffering and death, as well as the demands of discipleship.

The second part of the passage describes how the other ten disciples become angry with James and John. They are angry because they are envious that James and John requested a special place in God's kingdom before they had a chance.

This whole passage reveals the very human temptations with which all of us struggle: pride, envy, lust, greed, etc.

The second part of the Scripture passage ends with Jesus revealing that the secret to real glory and honor is found through self-sacrificing service. In short, a person must die to become a disciple of Jesus Christ.
