

SOLEMNITY OF MARY THE MOTHER OF GOD

Monday, January 1, is the Feast of the Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God. The National Conference of Catholic Bishops has lifted the obligation of Mass on holy days (Jan. 1, Aug. 15, and Nov. 1) when they fall on a Saturday or Monday, which is the case with January 1 this year. With this in mind and knowing that parishioners will choose to come to Mass, our New Year's Day Mass is at 8:00 AM.

If you are ill or are concerned about contracting the flu virus, you should refrain from shaking hands at the Sign of Peace. A smile, or nod, or a verbal "Peace be with you" are appropriate alternatives. Communicants who may be contagious should receive Holy Communion in the hand rather than the tongue. These gestures would be appreciated by all trying to keep well.


