Further details regarding June veneration services for Our Lady of Guadalupe will be

available from Masconomo Council 1232 Grand Knight Tom Finn. Catholic tradition and Mexican legend hold that on December 12, 1531 the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to a humble shepherd, Juan Diego, outside Mexico City on Tepayac Hill where she directed a shrine for prayer be built in her honor.

As proof of her miraculous apparition, the robed image of the Blessed Virgin Mary, her likeness as a native-American maiden was imprinted on Juan Diego's rough cactus fabric tilma, or cloak, to emphasize the supernatural character of the visit. The image on the tilma, proven not to have been painted, has survived nearly five hundred years and the assaults of bombs, fires and skeptics. The Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe where the tilma is displayed near Mexico City is now one of the world's most visited Catholic pilgrimage sites.
