
Thank you for your support of our recent efforts to retain Fr. Paul Flammia as Parish Administrator. Cardinal Sean and Bishop Peter have now reversed the previously announced decision and as a result Fr. Paul has been named and announced as our Parish Administrator, until further notice.

This was an important exercise in harnessing the prayers and the unified goodwill of our community and it was aided by a strong word of mouth among the many that lent their support.

To ensure that we are able to continue to carry on good work for the benefit of all in our community, we believe it is important to maintain good records and efficient communications and we have learned through this process the power of email as a fast and efficient communications medium.
