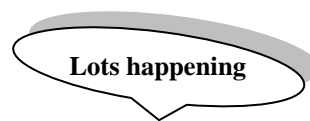

PARISH NOTICE/REMINDER

Since July 1, the beginning of this fiscal year, our Parish Finance Council (PFC) has been very attentive to the donation patterns of our parishioners. This week we take the opportunity to remind everyone of *two (2) guiding principles:*

1. Family households that donate less than \$50.00 per year will be **made inactive** in our census files (this will help cut the cost of purchasing envelopes for parishioners who are not using them)
2. Family households that donate less than \$150.00 for the last three (3) years **will be deleted** from our census files -- **This entire matter is under review by the PFC.**



PLEASE REMEMBER: *the only record of YOUR individual donations/support of the parish is through your use of offertory envelopes.* It could happen that your support/donations = ZERO [in our records] because you do not use envelopes.

AS WAS PUBLISHED IN RECENT BULLETINS, the **Parish Pastoral Council & Parish Finance Council** held a JOINT meeting this past week to discuss the current contribution patterns of our parishioners as we have suffered a very noticeable *decrease in income* over the last 12-18 months. This issue will not go away and we need to address it. More will be forthcoming!
