CRAFT NIGHT: Sunday, September 25th at 6:00 PM in the parish hall.



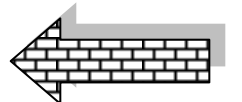

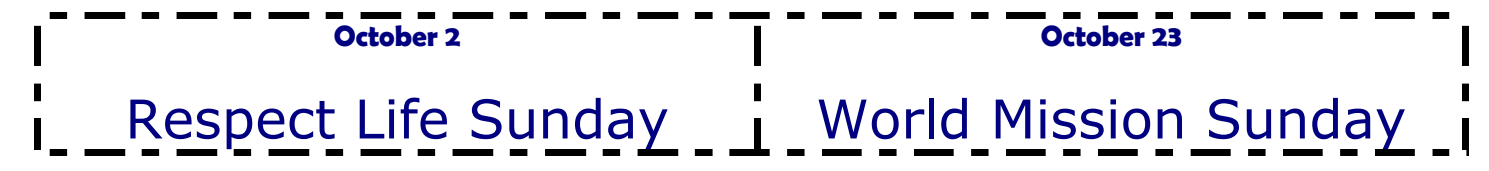
